Timeline for Nomination & Election Process

The general process and timeline for the nomination process is:

Nomination application deadline: August 26, 2022

The Alberta Sign Association President will present the slate of nominees presented to the Alberta Sign Association board for approval.

Members elect the directors at the Alberta Sign Association Annual General Meeting: **October 4, 2022** The board of director's votes on the proposed slate of directors. The vote is ratified by the members at the Annual General Meeting.

Criteria Used for the Selection of Board of Directors Candidates

In reviewing candidates, the Alberta Sign Association Directors will consider the following:

Leadership and experience in the sign industry

Involvement with and service to SAC and/or Alberta Sign Association

Proven leadership attributes and the ability to work collaboratively and engage in debate and discussion

Commitment to participate in all required meetings in person

Strong network within the sign industry

Ability to represent the Alberta Sign Association as an ambassador with agencies and other organizations

Nominees must complete the Nomination Form. This ensures the information under review is the same from all candidates and recognizes the nominee's level of commitment.
