Family Play - Game Challenge

GUIDELINES

GOAL: Create a COVID-safe outside game challenge for your family, friends and/or neighbors.

WHAT: A homemade, child-friendly Croquet or Putt Putt Golf challenge or other traditional or creative outdoor game of your choice.

WHEN: Plan a date in August or September for your Family Play – Game Challenge before Labor Day.

WHERE: Your yard or driveway as part of the circuit created with friends and neighbors.

HOW: Organize a group of families, friends/neighbors to create a COVID-safe, outdoor, child-friendly game challenge as part of a circuit. Each household plans and creates their own croquet, putt putt golf or other outdoor game challenge as one “hole” or challenge in the circuit.

Decide the logistics for families taking turns at each location to maintain COVID-safe protocols (MASKS, 6 FT BETWEEN ALL participants as well as spectators, HAND-SANITIZER for shared golf clubs, croquet mallets, etc.) Decide which location each family will begin their course to help maintain physical distancing and if participating families will walk or drive to each location? Decide who will be invited to participate or spectate besides those who are hosting game challenges?

Have fun creating & playing - think outside the box! Look around for materials/equipment you have or can borrow. Use recyclable materials (e.g. boxes, milk cartons, tubes). Plan child-friendly game challenges that include your children in the creative thinking and making process. Support their ideas, encourage the collaborative problem-solving process and create the game props together. Supervise safe use of tools.
