



Grant Opportunity: The Falmouth Fund

PLEASE NOTE: *The grant application process and deadline have changed for 2021. The Falmouth Fund is only considering general grants this year. Read the information below and the instructions on the application carefully.*

The Falmouth Fund is a resource that is responsive to diverse needs and opportunities across the community. The Fund invests in activities that strengthen and enhance the community in the following areas: health and human services; education, youth and recreation; arts and culture; and the environment.

In recognition of the unprecedented challenges and unanticipated opportunities created by the COVID-19 pandemic, the focus of The Falmouth Fund's grant program for 2021 will be on priority needs with community-wide impact that will support the recovery and rebuilding process. Grants can address an organization's response to the effects of the pandemic including:

- new programs or projects
- ongoing activities
- operational support

Other Guidelines:

- All grants must serve the residents of Falmouth.

- The Falmouth Fund does not generally consider requests for Capital Campaigns, Capital Improvements, Endowment Building, Monuments, or Memorial Projects.

Review Process

The Falmouth Fund Grant Review Committee reviews the grant proposals submitted and makes recommendations to The Cape Cod Foundation Board of Directors for formal approval. In general, award notifications and the disbursement of funds are made within three months of the application deadline.

About The Falmouth Fund

Established in 2009, The Falmouth Fund has awarded more than \$700,000 in grants to 80 nonprofit organizations serving the Falmouth community. In recent years, the average grant award from The Falmouth Fund has been about \$3,000. To date in 2020, The Falmouth Fund awarded \$100,000 in grants to 31 nonprofit organizations at its annual grant ceremony in March and an additional \$42,500 in grants since then to five nonprofits that are addressing basic human needs for vulnerable populations that have been impacted by the pandemic.
