Recovery Support Available at Dennis Public Library

The Town of Dennis has partnered with Duffy Health Center to offer residents access to recovery support services in their own community. A Recovery Support Navigator is available for drop-in services in the Benjamin and Ruth Muse Meeting Room at the Dennis Public Library in Dennis Port. The program began on Tuesday, September 7th and will continue weekly, every Tuesday from 2:00 to 4:00pm.

The Recovery Support Navigator is a person who provides non-clinical services to individuals seeking treatment for a substance use disorder. They are available to offer guidance in identifying recovery goals and assist individuals in connecting to appropriate social services and other resources. Any person who is struggling with a substance use disorder is welcome to drop in to speak with a Recovery Support Navigator in a non-judgmental environment. The Recovery Support Navigator can also be reached by phone at (508) 776-8428.

This service is free and confidential. Sessions with the Recovery Support Navigator will be held in a one-on-one, closed-door environment. There is no time limit on sessions; they will be based on the individual needs of the community member.

Duffy Health Center is a community health center located in Hyannis and is a regional leader in addressing substance use disorders and supporting individuals in their recovery journey. The mission of Duffy Health Center is to provide equitable, integrated primary health care and support services to persons who are experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness on Cape Cod, and to improve the quality of life for vulnerable and marginalized populations through community collaborations, leadership, and advocacy.
