There will be 4 more upcoming dates (each Saturday in October) of 1050 cases of food (per distribution) at the college, from 9am-1pm, or until we run out of boxes.

- October 10th
- October 17th
- October 24th
- October 31st

Important Notes:

- Cars will not be allowed to line up until 8am
- You will only be able to pick up 1 box per car - no exceptions
- We will NOT begin distributing food boxes before 9am
- You must follow the signs upon entering the college to the Food Distribution line
- This is open to anyone that needs the food. There is no registration or income eligibility requirements.
- There may be long lines, but they move quickly
- The Food Distribution takes place in Lot 12, 7/10ths of a mile after you enter campus
- Do not exit your vehicle
- Once in the queue in Lot 12, please pop your trunk so we can place the box in the vehicle for you
