School Hours

- 7:20am (Doors Open) and students are stagger dismissed between 2:41-2:46pm

Drop Off/Pick Up (Do not arrive before 7:20)

- **6-7 Grade**- Parents drop off and pick up at the blue awning on Decatur Street
- **8-12 Grade**- Student Drivers Park in the Sts. Peter & Paul School (Haughland) Parking Lot or on street parking. If you are dropping off or picking up a student in grades 8-12, you can drop off or pick them up on West Jefferson Street ticket lobby doors or use the stone lot on corner of W. Jefferson and Decatur Street.
