Q & A for Manufacturing Career Exploration Day @ Whirlpool Clyde Operations

Q. What is Manufacturing Career Exploration Day?

A. It's a day where Clyde Operations is opening their doors to Middle School, High School and College students to "see" the career opportunities within the manufacturing walls. Throughout the self guided tour, areas will be highlighting the work that is done, as well as; the associated skill sets and careers in that area. Q. What kind of careers does Manufacturing offer?

(This address is for GPS purposes only. You will actually drive past the 650 entrance, go under the blue tunnel that goes across the street and then turn left into the parking lot.)
