2. Proposal submission does not guarantee acceptance.
3. Bio and workshop content will be used in the conference program. You may be asked to edit or revise your proposal.
4. Preference for selection will be given to proposals that address or complement the conference theme, provide an interactive learning opportunity, and list the expected learning outcomes. Other topics of importance to career professionals will also be considered, with the same criteria.
5. Workshops whose primary focus is to sell a product or service will not be accepted.
6. Presenters are responsible for supplying and/or duplicating their handouts. An approximate number of workshop attendees will be given to the presenters a minimum of one week before the conference.
7. Presenters will be notified of acceptance after the March 2020 MCDA Conference Committee meeting. Please understand that we cannot provide presenters an honorarium, but invite them to participate in the conference as our guests free of charge.
