I am, of course, always interested in what my constituents consider to be important. Below is a list of issues we are considering for the 2024 legislative session. Please look them over, let me know if there are any that I've missed and which ones are most important to you.

- *Requiring that state-owned properties use compostable yard waste bags;*
- *Providing more protection for endangered species;*
- *Addressing the issue of mold in college dorm rooms;*
- *Providing for ADA-compliant playground equipment (ADA is the Americans With Disabilities Act);*
- *Implementing a tax on heavy commercial trucks and funneling the revenue into the state's highway-user fund for highway repairs;*
- *Creating an employer tax credit for transit passes;*
- *Improving disability accessibility of playgrounds by including symbol communication sign boards;*
