Ohio Municipal League Announces Schneck as Director of Public Affairs

[COLUMBUS, Ohio, June 16, 2022] – The Ohio Municipal League has announced that Bevan Schneck will serve as the league's director of public affairs.

In his new role – which he started on June 6, 2022 – Schneck will be leading and executing OML's communications strategies, managing media relations efforts and serving as a member of the league's advocacy team.

"As the son of a former, small-town mayor and as an active participant in municipal government today, I have a familiarity and keen understanding of the important role villages and cities play in creating a better quality of life for Ohio residents," Schneck said. "I'm thrilled to be at OML, working at the intersection of municipal and state government and contributing to the enactment of better public policy."

Schneck comes to OML from the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission, an association of local governments in the 15-county, central Ohio region. He previously served on the communications team at the Ohio House of Representatives under Speaker William G. Batchelder – having started as an Ohio Legislative Service Commission fellow. He was also the communications director on former Congressman Steve Stivers' 2014 campaign.

"Bevan brings a great skill set to our director of public affairs position," OML Executive Director Kent Scarrett said. "With past experience in communications, at the statehouse and working with local governments, we're confident he'll make an impact at OML and work hard for the more than 700 municipalities we represent."

Schneck is a graduate of The Ohio State University, where he received his bachelor's degree in journalism and political science. A native of northwest Ohio, he now resides in the Columbus suburb of Hilliard.
