Erin's Law (House Bill 6193) was signed into Illinois law in 2013. This law requires schools to implement an age-appropriate sexual assault and abuse awareness and prevention curriculum for grades pre-K through 12. Victor Pacini, a survivor of sexual abuse and motivational speaker, will be assisting our elementary schools in implementing this mandate.

Mr. Pacini's program is developmentally appropriate, interactive, and aligned with learning standards.
The focus of his presentation is to teach children basic skills to keep them safe from dangerous or abusive situations.

Mr. Pacini will be presenting virtually at each of the three elementary schools. The dates for the student presentations at each building are as follows:
