Some zebrafish genetic lines go back several years through a lab's painstaking work, and it would be a devastating blow to their research to lose their fish.

- Brand new large-scale zebrafish facility installed at University College London

- Multiple stand alone rack systems installed at Washington University St. Louis, featuring a Miele tank washer
- A Recirculating Modular Stream System was installed at University of Toronto, consisting of twenty-four 2000-liter polyethylene round tanks with specially-designed connectors that mimic riffle-pool sequences.
