- When an informational error is brought to the attention of the Boyne Citizen, if valid, a correction will run prominently in the next edition.
- Typographical errors or misspellings that do not change an article's overall meaning will not be formally corrected.
- If a misleading article is run, it will be replaced with a retraction notice.
- When possible, it will be stated how an error was discovered.
- Running corrections is the responsibility of the editor.
