- Submit this letter of intent with the required signatures to verify that you have the permission and support of your parents and your unit leader.

Lodge officers have the following responsibilities:

- Perform the officer's duties which are listed in the lodge rules.
- Attend lodge meetings, lodge executive committee meetings, and section meetings to the best of the officer's ability.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law at all times.
