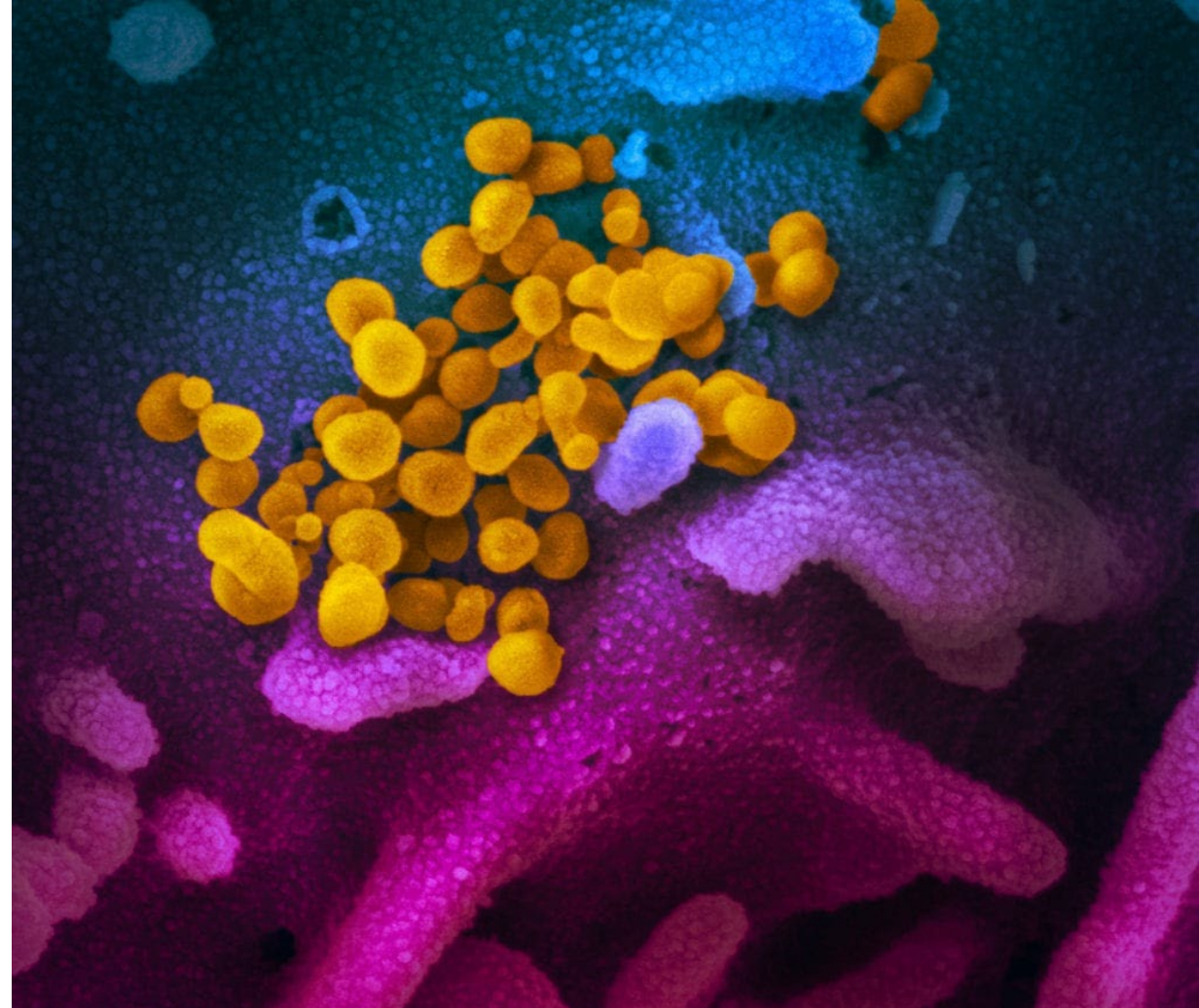

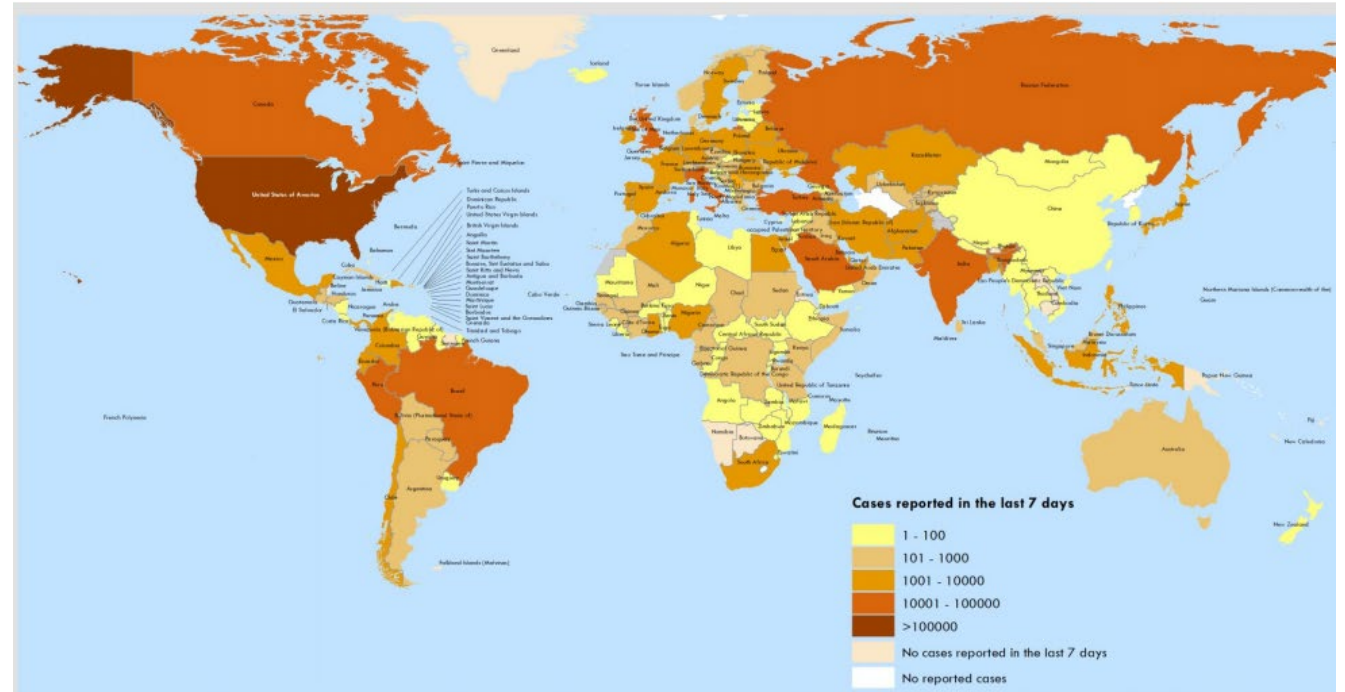

- Cases
 - Total: 4,170,424 cases
 - Past 24 hrs: 81,577
- Deaths
 - Total: 287,399
 - Past 24 hrs: 4,245



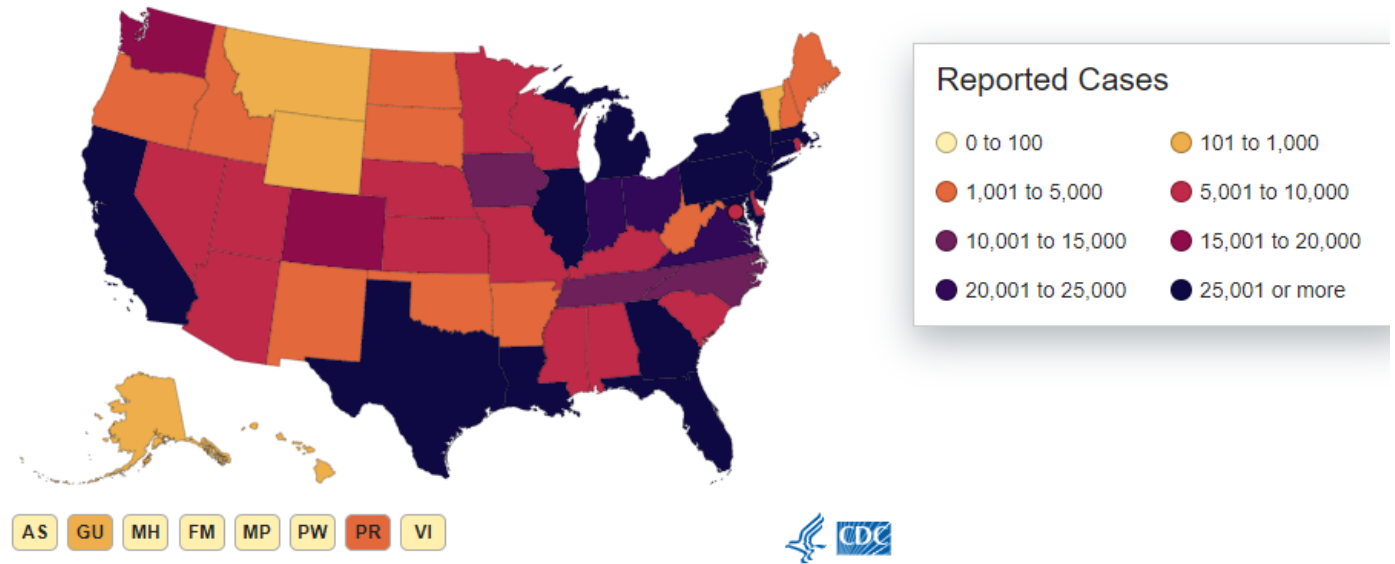

United States: Confirmed COVID-19 Cases

- Total Cases: 1,364,061
 - New 22,393
- Total deaths 82,246
 - New 1,426
- Total Jurisdictions:55

21 states report more than 10,000 cases of COVID-19.

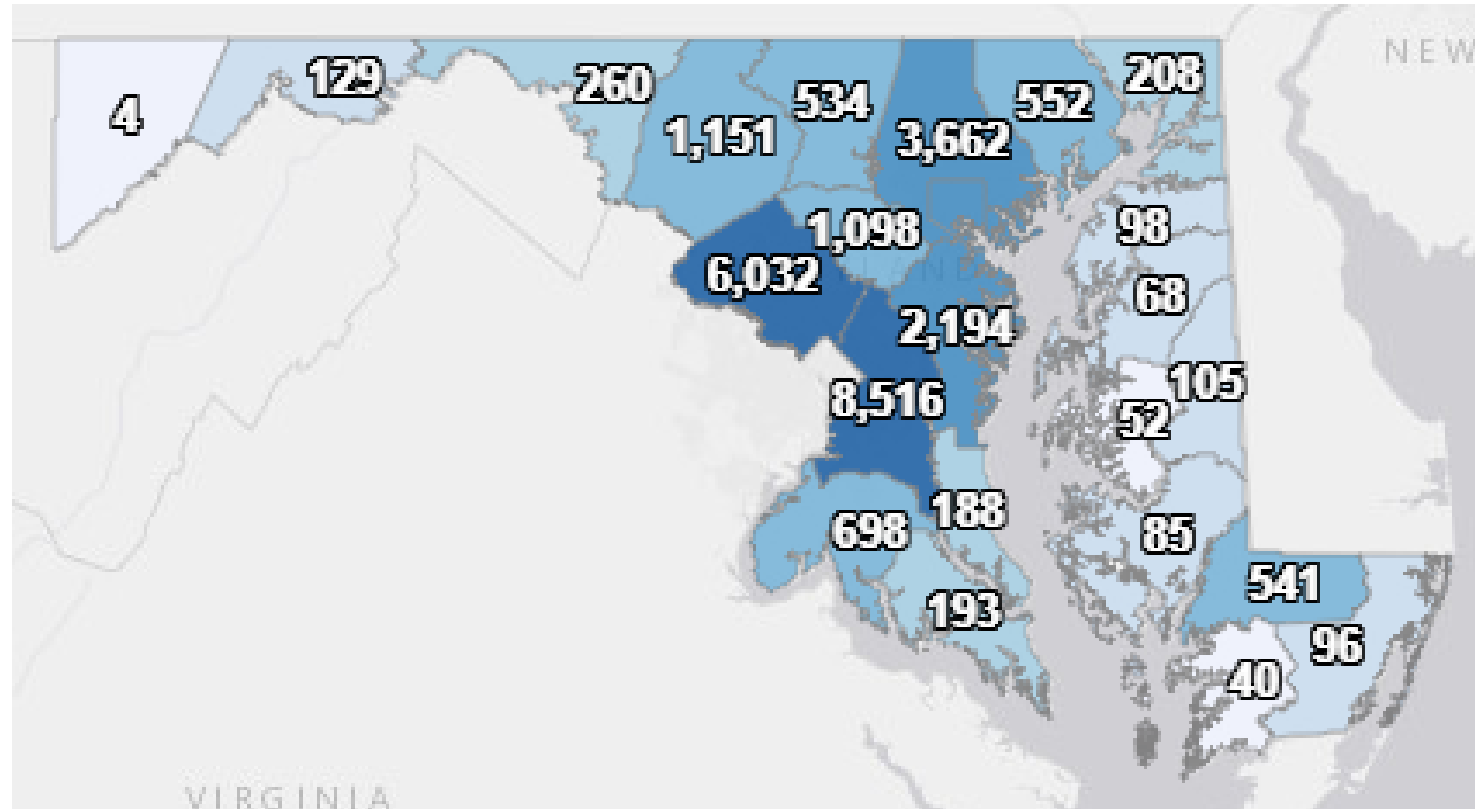

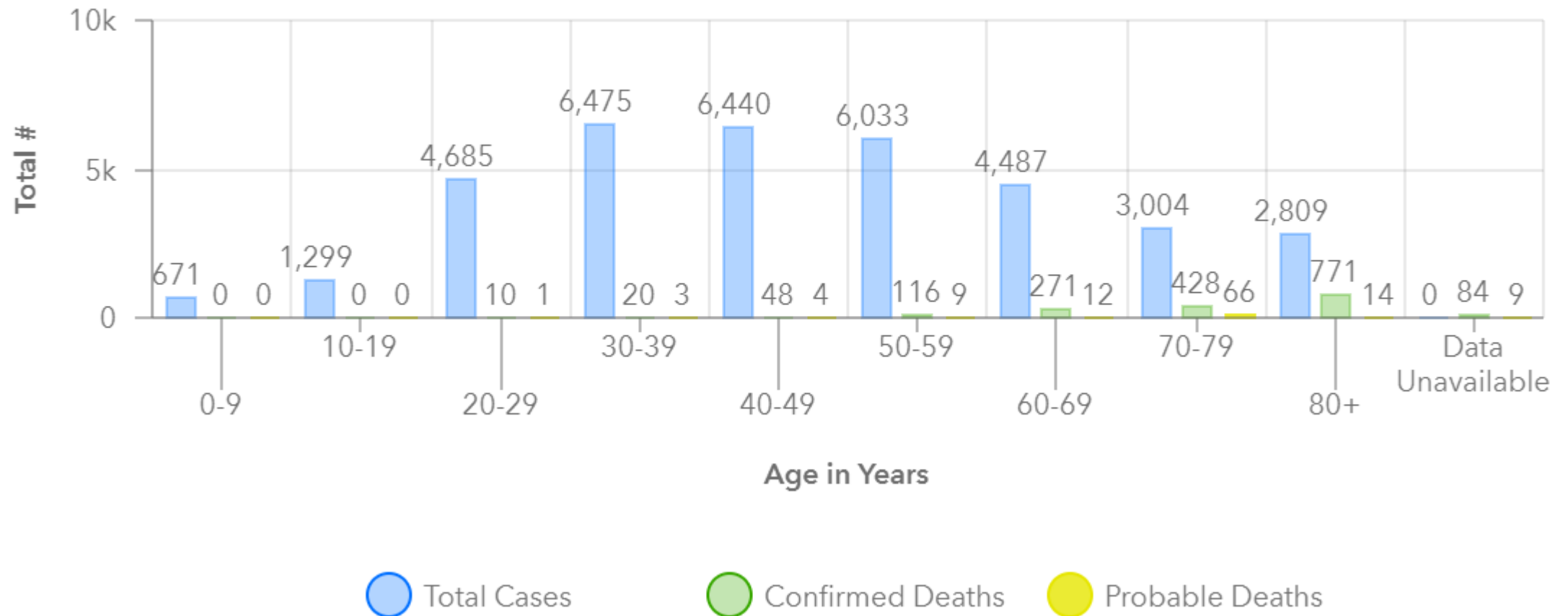
Maryland: Confirmed COVID-19 Cases

- Confirmed cases: 35,903
 - Last 24 hours - 1,091
- Negative test results: 142,551
 - Last 24 hours - 3789
- Confirmed Deaths: 1,748
 - Last 24 hours - 54
- Currently Hospitalized: 1,538
 - Last 24 hours: -12



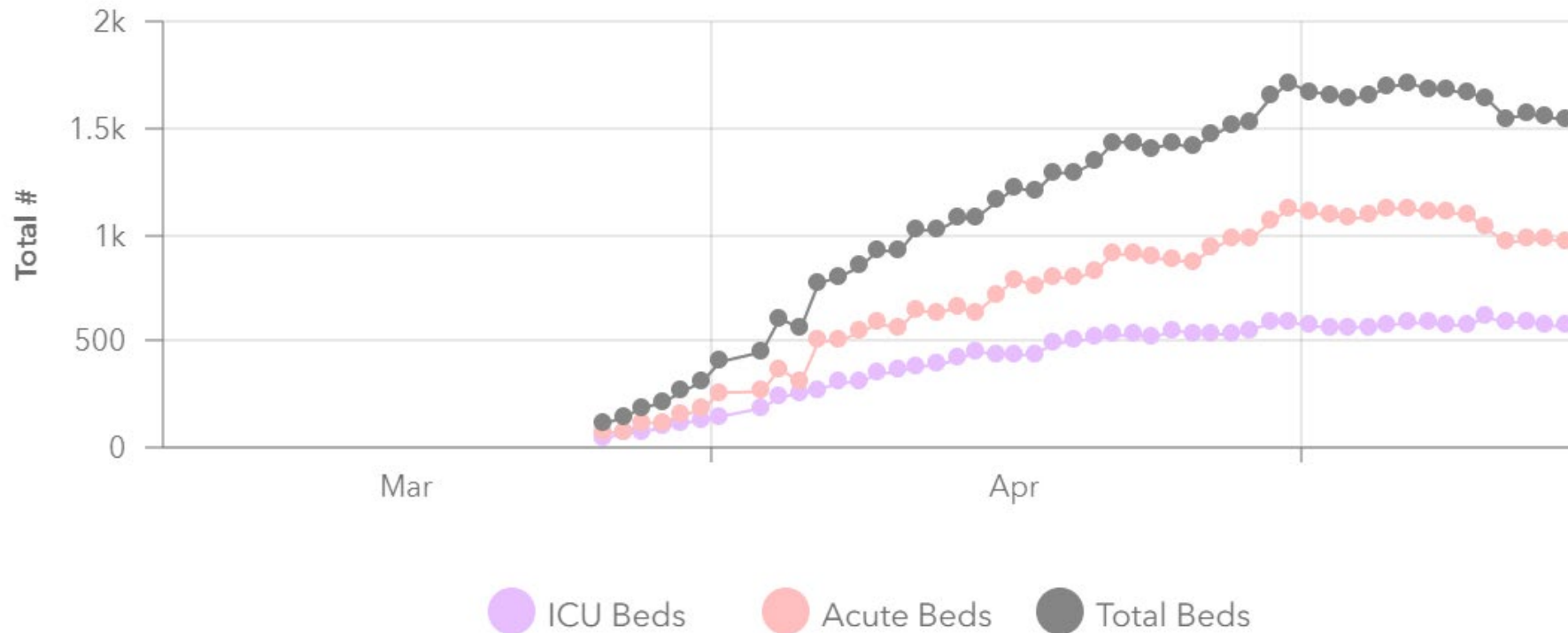

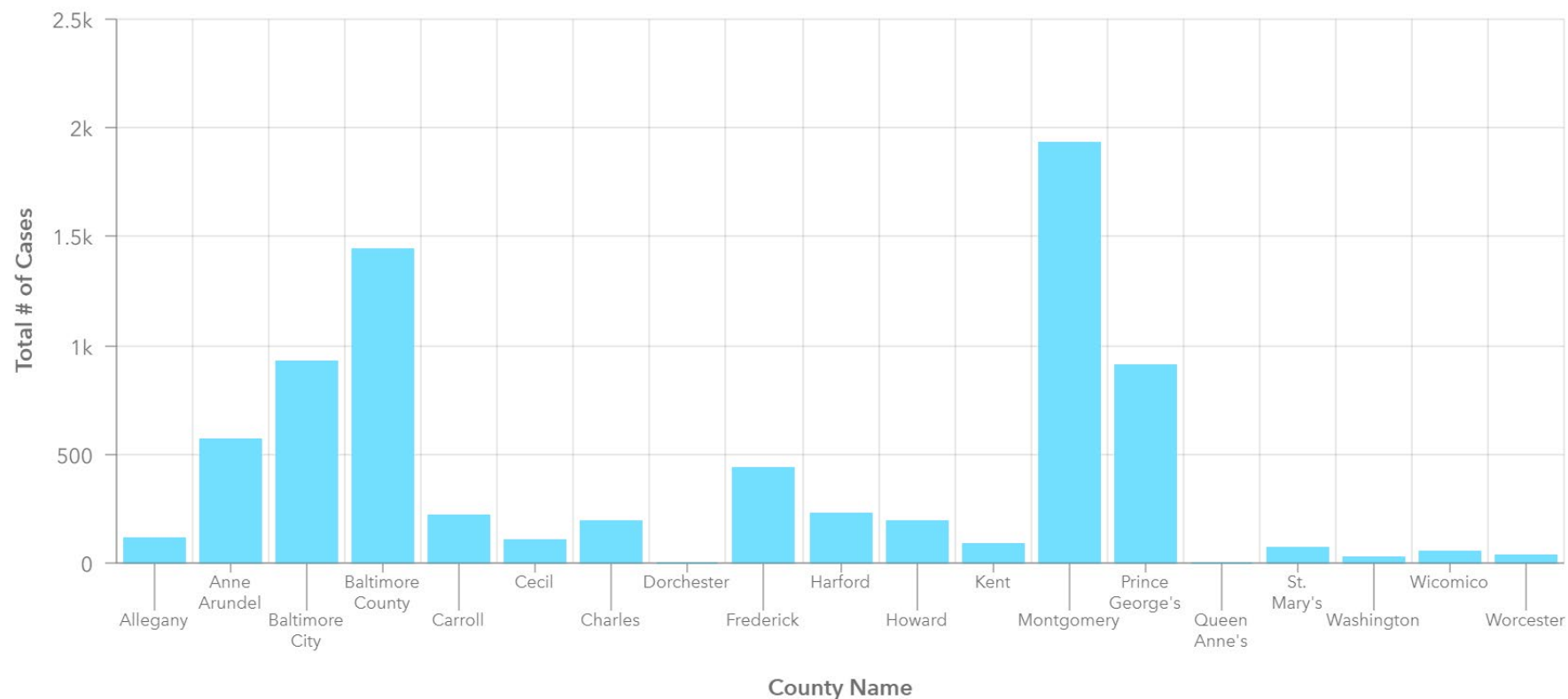

Frequently Asked Questions

- What type of facilities are required to participate in universal testing?
- Will the guard be re-testing at facilities who have already completed universal testing?

CDC Updates

Considerations for Memory Care Units

- Dedicate personnel to the memory care unit
- Consider removing positive residents from memory care
- Dedicate staff to positive residents in memory care and/or cluster memory care residents on the unit
- Stagger activities throughout the day
- Consider additional testing when a resident is identified on a memory care unit
- The 3 R's - Redirection, Reminders, Reorientation

 - Feeling – Irritation, anger, denial, helpless, anxious, uncertain, tired, overwhelmed, burned out, sad, depressed

 - Take care of your body & engage in healthy coping

MDH Updates

Stage One of the Roadmap to Recovery

- May 13th Governor Hogan announced commencement of phase one including moving from a stay at home order to a safer at home advisory and the gradual reopening of retail, manufacturing, houses of worship, and some personal services.
- Commencement of phase one does not change recommendations from CDC, MDH, and CMS for long-term care facilities
- Long-term care facilities should continue to restrict visitation, actively screen employees, and encourage healthcare personnel to maintain social distancing in and out of the workplace.

New lab tests for COVID-19

- MDH Laboratory is now running 3 different assays:
 - 2019-nCoV Real-Time RT-PCR (CDC)
 - Abbott RealTime SARS-CoV-2 Assay
 - Cepheid GeneXpert SARS-Cov-2 Assay
- All are PCR-based assays
- Results should all be treated the same
- Decision to use a particular assay is just based on what is available at time specimen is ready to run
