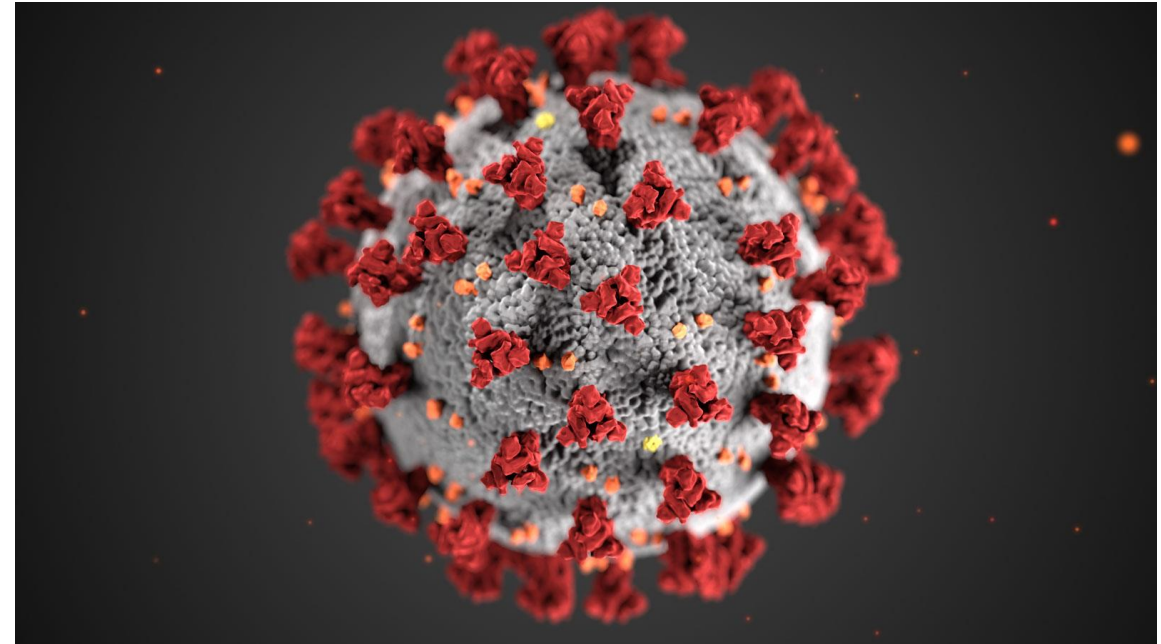

  - Total Deaths: **788,593**

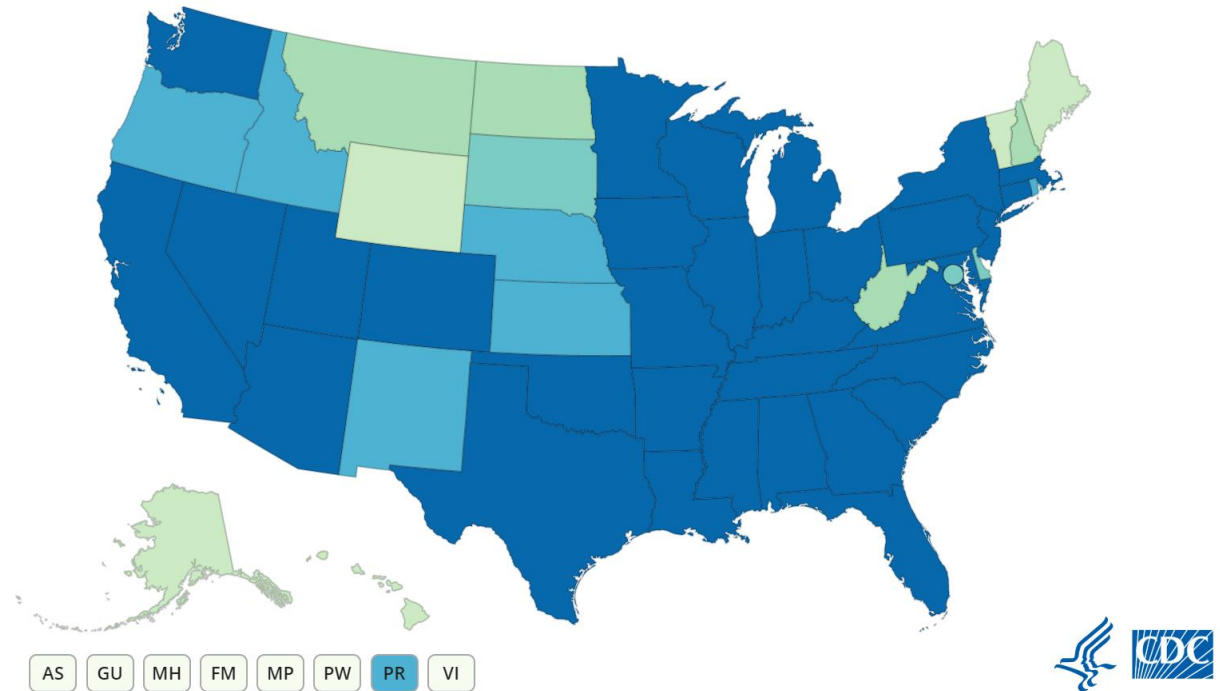

- 24hrs: 1,172 NEW



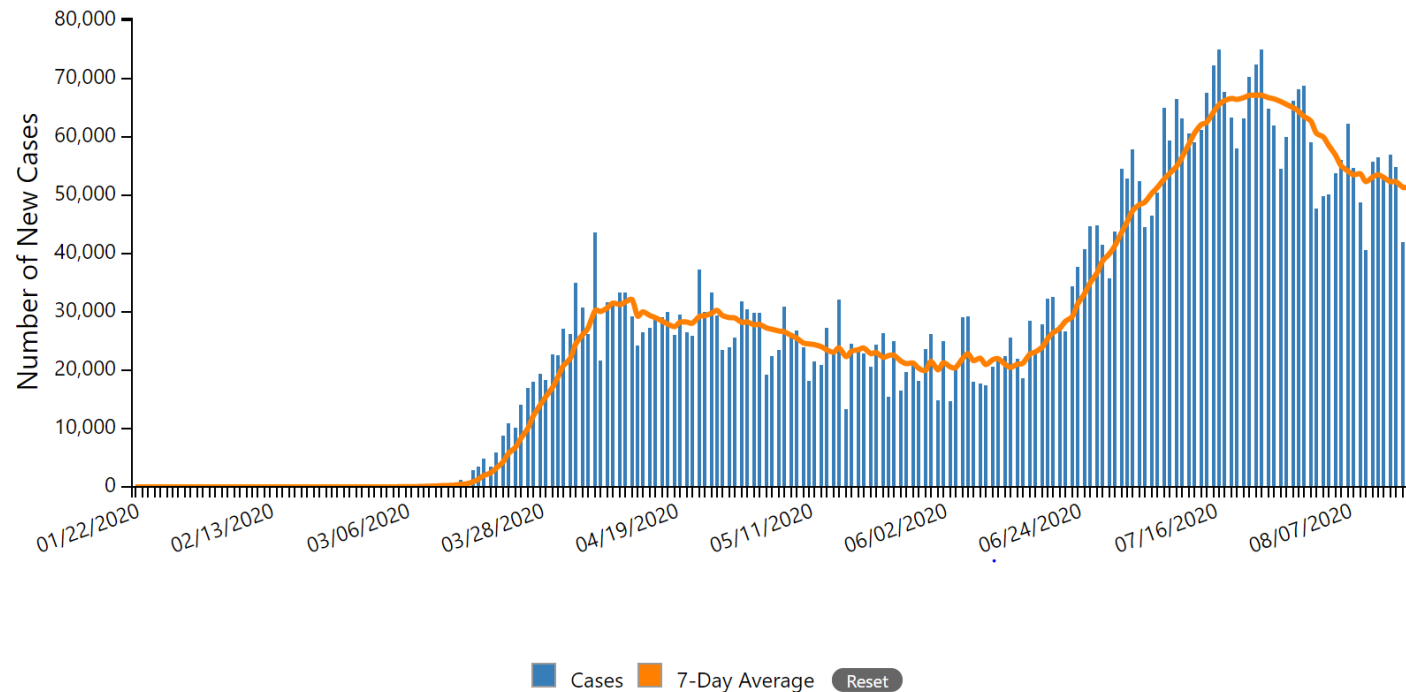

# New Cases by Day in US

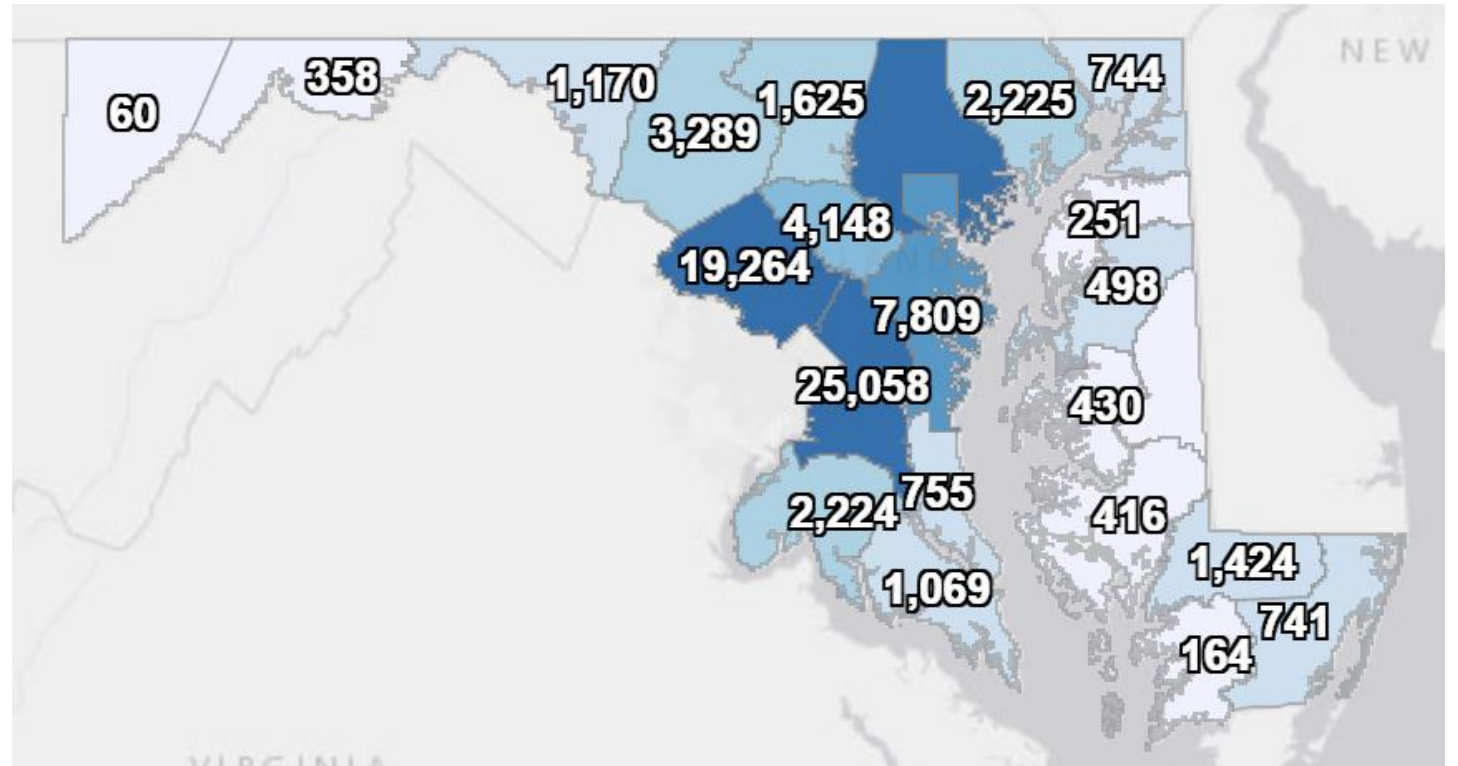
## New Cases by Day

# Maryland: COVID-19

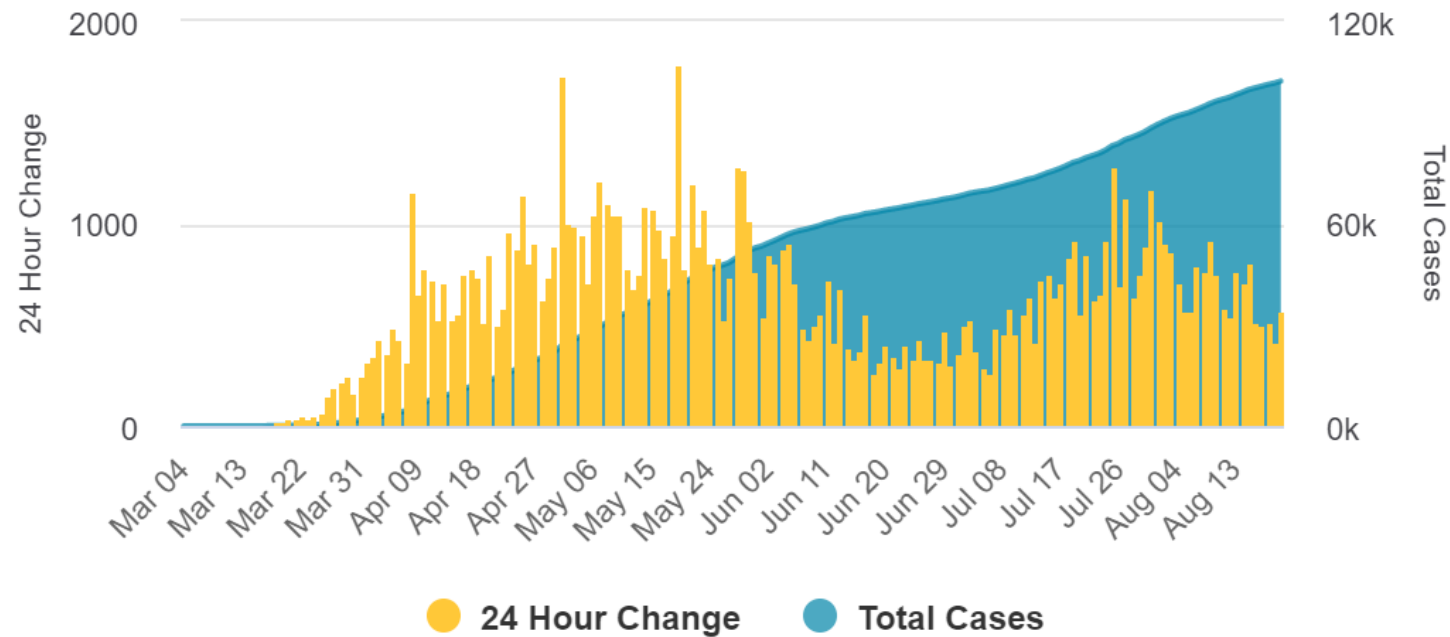
- Confirmed cases: **102,229**

Confirmed Cases, Total over Time

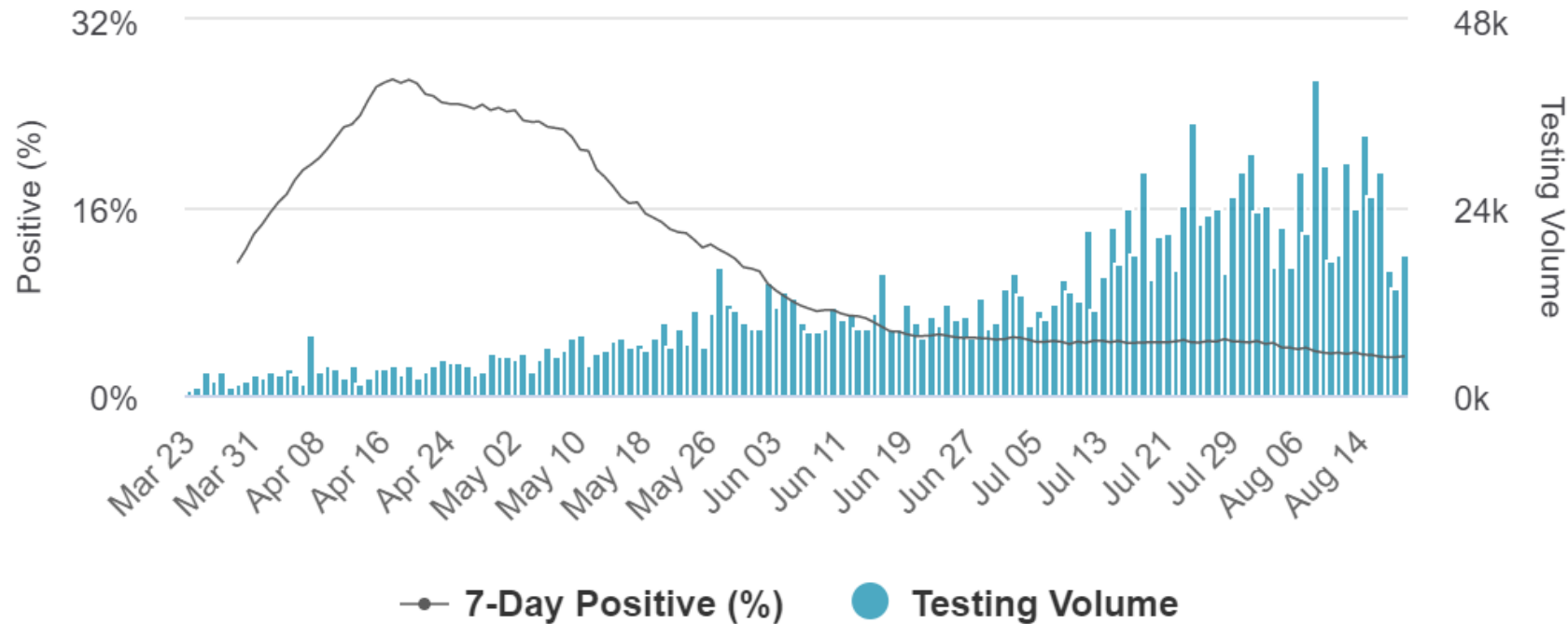

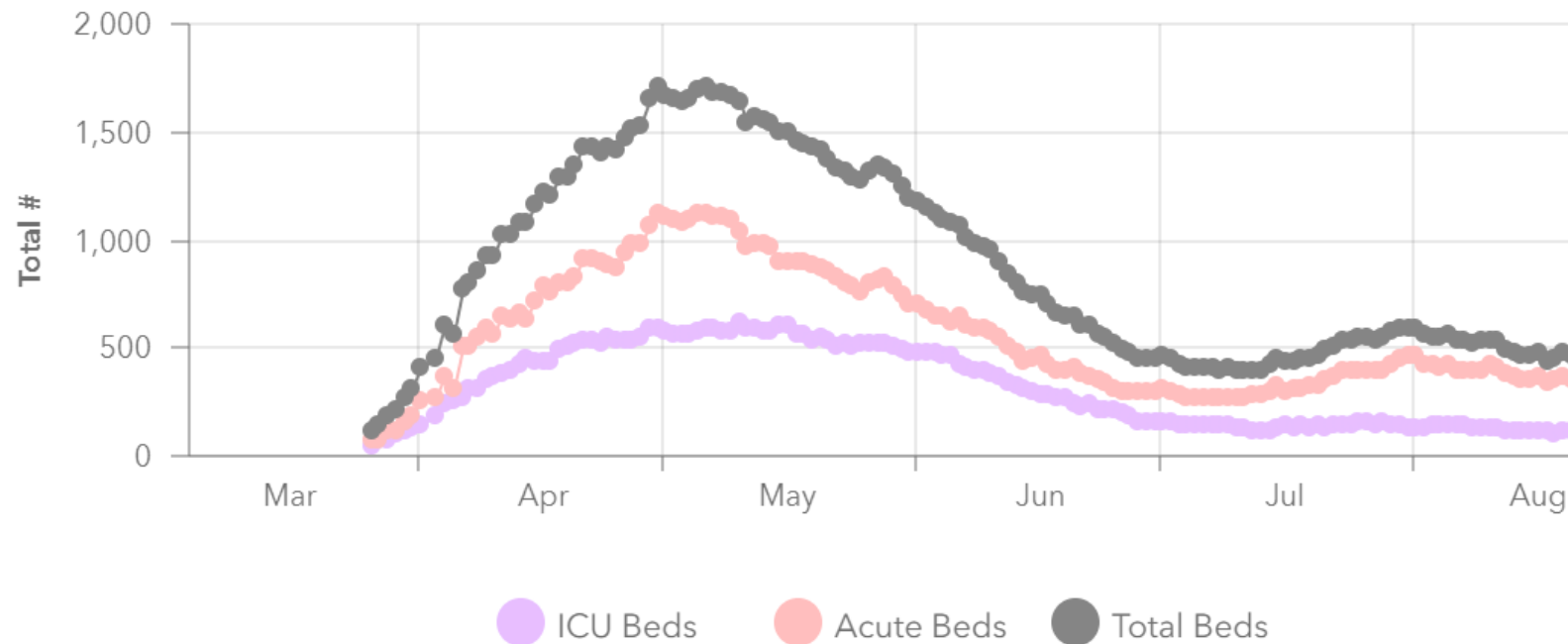

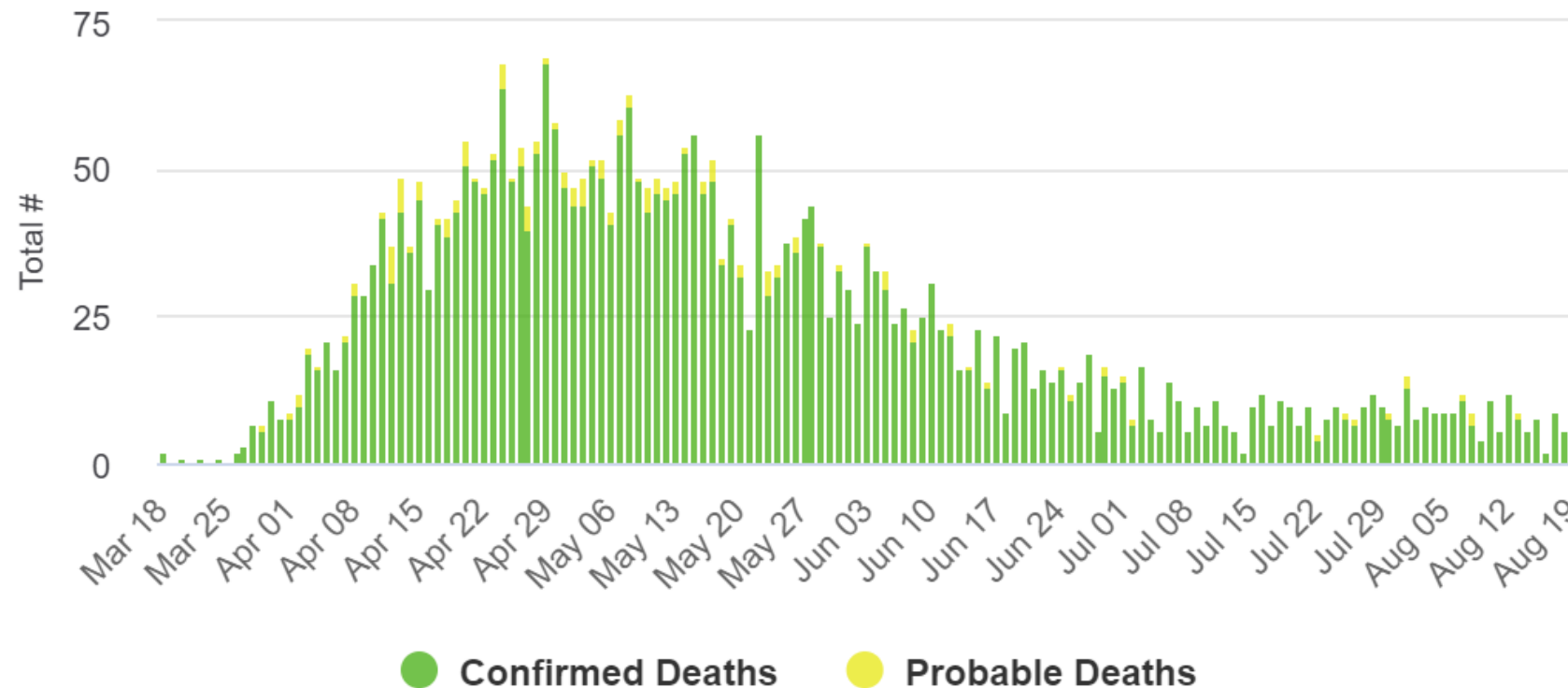
ICU and Acute Hospital Beds for COVID-19, Currently in Use

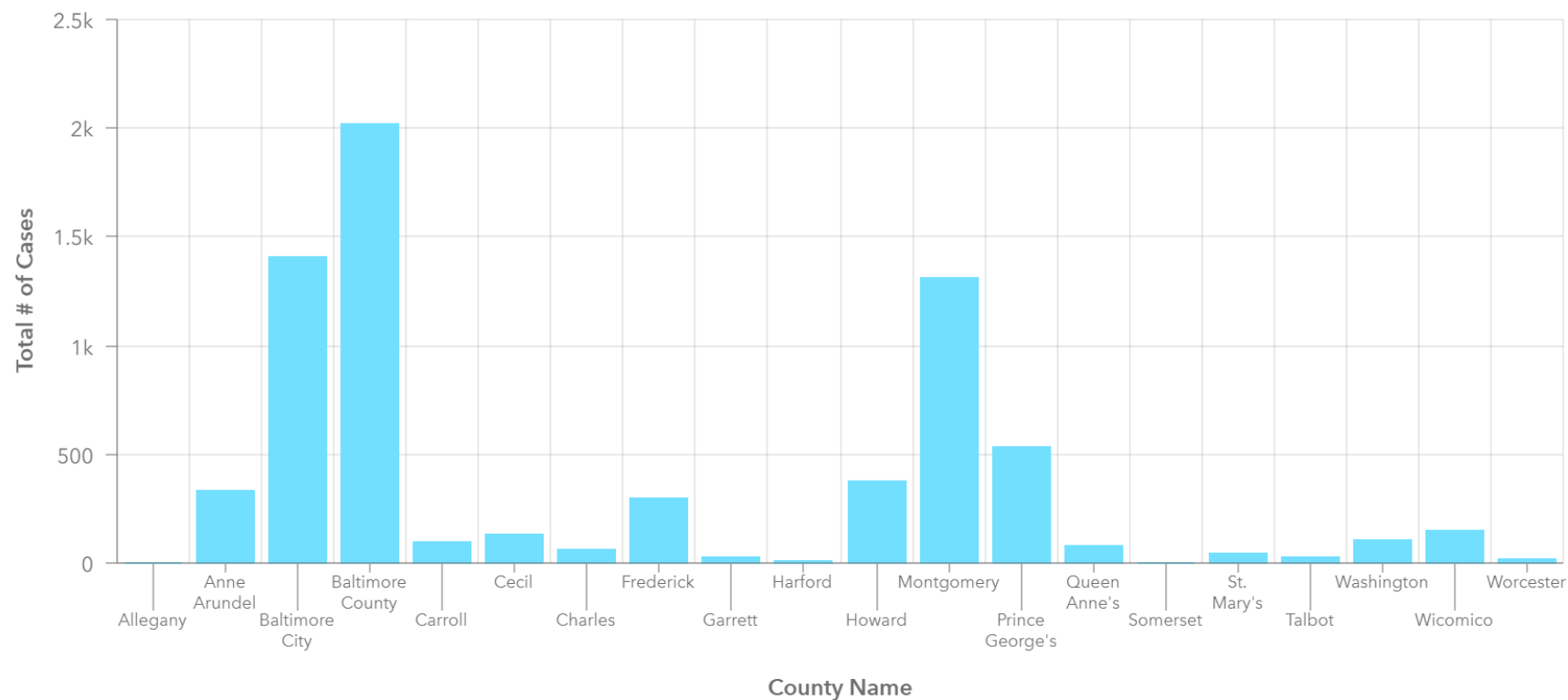

# Testing Taskforce Updates

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# Managing Admissions and Re admissions

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- August 13<sup>th</sup> Update revised recommendations on the “last resort” rule for managing admissions and re admissions
- Facilities may **ONLY** cohort as a last resort residents who are being **re admitted** to the facility.
- May ONLY be cohorted with another resident on observation
- Provided acceptable cohorting options for re admissions when no single rooms are available
- New admissions should only be admitted to a single person room unless COVID + or transmission-based precautions removed for COVID-19 removed within 90 days of admission.

# Last resort options for Re admissions

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1. If a facility does not have an open single-person room on the observation unit available for the re admission of a resident, options for their placement **might** include a shared room with another resident on the observation unit or a private room on a general population unit.
2. The resident **should** be placed in a single-person room (without a roommate), **ideally** in a separate observation area (i.e. a separate unit, floor, or wing of the facility) where all residents will be monitored and isolated on contact and droplet precautions for 14 days. If a separate observation area is not available, a resident **may** be isolated to a single-person room anywhere within the facility, using contact and droplet precautions.

# When a single-person room is not available for a re admission

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- Consider pairing two residents who have already been on observation the longest to create a private bed in the observation unit for the re admission
- If not currently cohorting staff on the observation unit, consider placing a resident on contact and droplet precautions in a private room in the general population instead of a cohorted room on the observation unit.
