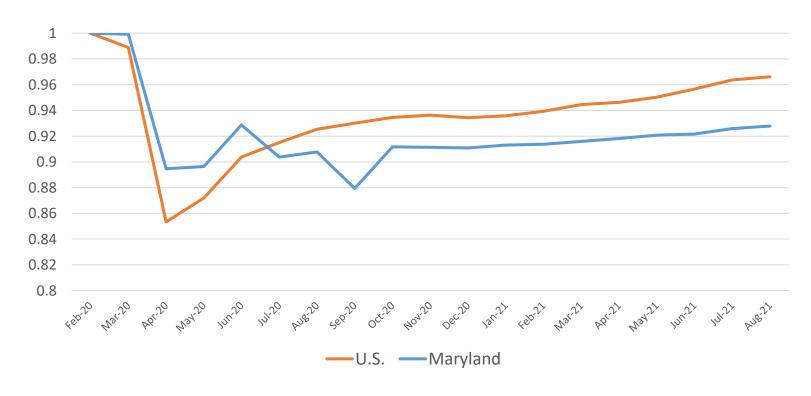

Total Employment U.S. vs Maryland February 2020 – August 2021 Index February 2020 = 1

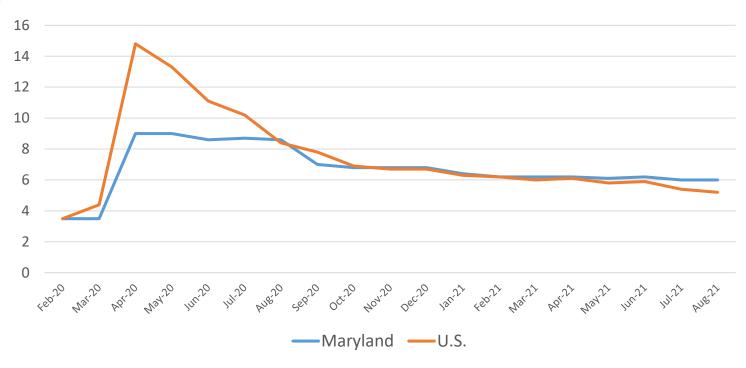

Unemployment Rate Maryland vs U.S. February 2020 – August 2021 Percent

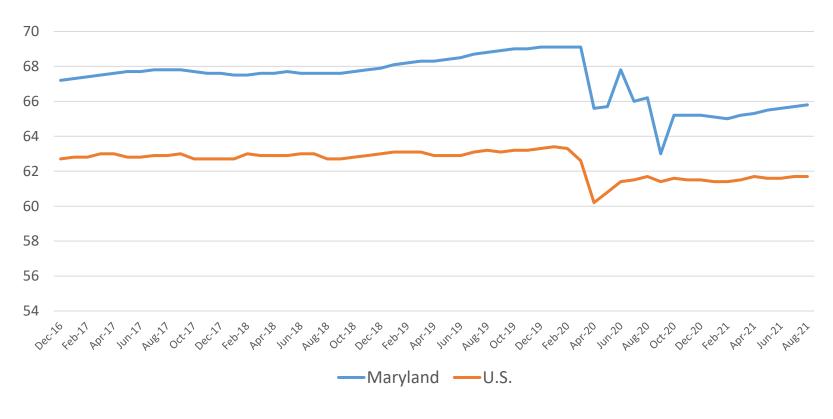

Labor Force Participation Rate U.S. vs Maryland December 2016 – August 2021



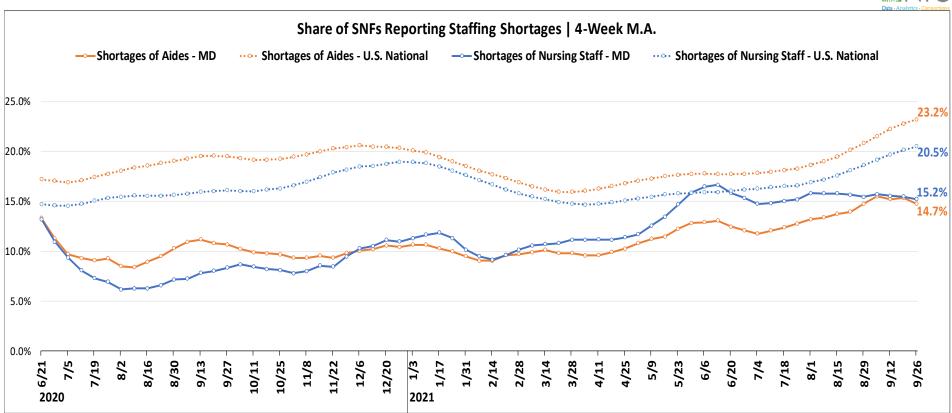
