## **GENERAL PROCEDURE REMINDERS**

- Do not travel with food, resources, or other items between isolation areas, observation areas, and general areas. (Example: Food carts and food delivery should be segregated specifically by isolation, observation, and general areas.)
- Waste and biowaste, including used PPE gowns, should not be transported through the general part of centers. (Example: Waste from the COVID-19 unit should not be transported through general or observation areas to dispose of it.)
- Surgical masks and other face coverings must securely cover your nose and mouth.
- PPE must be donned correctly before entering the patient area.

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 PPE must remain in place and be worn correctly for the duration of work in potentially contaminated areas. PPE should not be adjusted (e.g., retying gown, adjusting respirator/facemask) during patient care.
