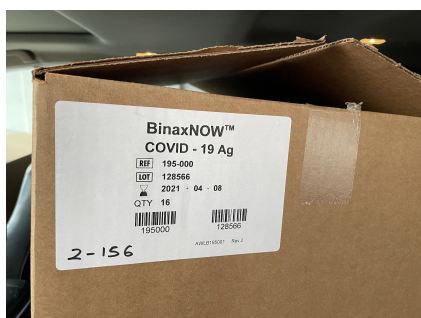




Dear Testing Administrator,

We wanted to bring several things to your attention regarding Abbott BinaxNOW COVID-19 rapid antigen point of care (POC) tests you may have in your inventory:

1. **Expiration dates for some BinaxNOW tests have been extended:** Please see the attached letter, highlighting which Abbott BinaxNOW test lots may be impacted. Please do not dispose of any tests before you refer to the attached file to see if yours have been given an extended expiration date. You will need to locate the LOT number on the BinaxNow kits (box of 40 tests). Here is are screen shots to help you locate that information:



2. **The US Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is offering a platform for COVID-19 Test Exchange:** The goal of the Test Exchange is to provide an easy way for facilities to either ask for additional Abbott BinaxNOW tests or offer surplus tests. Through the test exchange, you will be "matched" with another facility or state that is in the opposite situation. You will be provided their contact information and then you would negotiate transport, shipping, or any other logistical information. Depending on the distance of your match, you may need to pay for shipping but this would be negotiated between the two parties.
