



Guidance for Outdoor Visits at Assisted Living Facilities in Maryland (revised 6/19/2020)

Outdoor visitation at assisted living facilities is allowable if:

- 1) Visitors and residents wear a face covering at all times.
- 2) Visitors and residents maintain proper social distancing at all times.
- 3) There is NOT an ongoing outbreak at the facility.

Additionally, it is strongly recommended that there are no more than 2 visitors at a time per resident per visit.
