ITEMS NEEDED TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY:

- Completed NAM Relief Assistance Application
- Photo ID
- FEMA Registration number
- Proof of disaster impact (e.g., letters from FEMA, insurance, or Red Cross stating that there was damage to property or possessions, past lease)
- Proof of income prior to the hurricane (pay-stubs)
