The COVID-19 Special Initiative is a new \$10 million dollar program from the Texas Workforce Commission developed in direct response to the pandemic outbreak. The initiative emphasizes training for business partners

experiencing delays due to closures and business shutdowns. The program pays up to \$2,000 per employee for training received over a 12-month period.

Eligibility

- Employers must pay wages for each occupation equal to or greater than the prevailing wage for the local labor market for training to be funded under this grant.
- Employers will provide assurance that employees receiving training are fulltime, permanent employees or employees who have been furloughed.
