

SCHOOL SUPPLY SUGGESTION LIST

mostly for Pre K, K and 1st, 2nd, 3rd Grades

These are the most often requested supplies

Crayola crayons, fat for Pre-K and K (washable preferred)
Crayola crayons 24 count (**no 64's**) (washable preferred)
Crayola markers, both thick and thin (washable preferred)
- classic colors
Colored pencils (no more than 24 in a package)
Regular Yellow #2 pencils
Elmer's school glue
Glue sticks- especially large and jumbo size
Child size Fiskar scissors (they cut best), blunt for lower grades
Child size Fiskar scissors, sharp point for higher grades
Red ball point pens- for correcting
Ball point pens- black, blue, some green
3 x 5 lined index cards
Pocket folders-solid color- red, blue, green, yellow, purple
(pockets on bottom, with and without brads)
Dry erase markers (low odor) package of 4 regular basic colors
or single black thin markers
12" ruler, with inches and centimeters marked
Pink Erasers (eg. Pink Pearl)
3 inch x 3 inch "Post-its"
Highlighters (especially yellow) fat and thin
Pencil box for supplies or sturdy zipper case for pencils
Black and white marble composition books
Spiral notebooks, single and 3 subject-WIDE lines only
Three ring binders- 1", 1 ½", 2" wide
Three ring binder dividers
Loose leaf paper, WIDE lines only
Back Packs (smaller for younger children but big enough
for pocket folders to be put in easily)
Hand sanitizer

Other supplies needed

Small pencil sharpeners that hold shavings
Small Webster's Dictionary
Black sharpies
Ziplock bags, qt., gallon size (small boxes)
Head phones- Dollar Store
