What is the PJ Pack program at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta at Egleston?

The PJ Pack program provides clothes to our patients and families that need them most. Each "PJ pack" has a PJ set, pair of underwear, and pair of socks. Our Social Work team distributes to families throughout the hospital who need an extra set of clothes.

What sizes are considered "urgent needs?"

While we appreciate all sizes, we are always in need of infant sizes (6-9 months, 12 months) and teen/young adult items (L and XL sizes).

What are some other things to keep in mind?

- All clothing must be brand new.
- A PJ set includes both a pajama top and bottom.
- Please remove hangers and tags.
- Please print the provided label, circle the correct size, and place it in the Ziploc bag.

- 2 Diapers
- Bib
- Socks

Each gallon or two gallon Ziploc bag will include:

- PJ Set (pajama top and bottom)
- Undies
- Socks
