REQUIREMENTS:

1. The applicant must be a member in good standing of a 4-H club or FFA chapter.
2. The applicant must have an animal entered to show at the 2024 Utah State Jr Livestock Show.
3. Finalists must be available for an interview (virtual or in-person) with the Scholarship Committee.
4. Completed applications need to be submitted by April 20, 2024 to usils100@gmail.com Additional pages are permitted for Application questions.
5. **Please include two (2) letters of recommendation with your application** - letters can be from teachers, youth leaders, employers or other persons well acquainted with, but not related to, the applicant.
6. Must be a graduating high school senior planning to attend a two or four-year college, university or vocational school in the academic year 2024-2025. If an applicant is not attending an educational or vocational institution, the applicant must be prepared to explain how this will be an investment in your future.(ex. purchase breeding stock, tools and equipment for a trade,etc.)
7. Please enclose a photo/head shot with your application. *Needs to be in .jpg format.*
