



12th Annual Cougars Championship Passing Tournament And Lineman Challenge!



When: Saturday, July 27, 2019 – The **LAST Weekend** before the WIAA no-contact period.


Time: Games begin at 9:00 AM and continue until the championship game in the evening.


Where: Lakewood High School. (15 miles north of Everett with easy I-5 access, Exit 206).


Format: Teams will be placed in 4 team divisions and will play round-robin within their division for 3 games. These games will determine seeding for the championship and consolation brackets.

Team Fee: \$325.00 (this includes the passing tournament AND lineman challenge). No individual player fees.

What makes the Cougar Championship Tournament UNIQUE?:

 This tournament that utilizes that **last possible weekend** before the WIAA mandated no-contact period. This can be a boost to get the team ready for the start of the regular season, or as a final team event to celebrate your great summer together. Each game is 36 minutes long, with two 18 minute halves. Overtime games are settled in a Kansas-City Tie Breaker format, just like your team would experience during the regular season.

 Another important feature of the Cougar Championship Tournament, is that all players will be required to **WEAR HELMETS** and mouth-guards for safety. No other pads will be worn, but this will help prevent any head or face injuries and allow the players to play with more confidence. With the increased awareness regarding concussions, we feel that this is the safest way to compete at full speed in a competitive tournament.

 **Ideal location**, in Snohomish County, with easy I-5 access at the Smokey Point Exit, which has a wealth of stores and restaurants. (5 Guys Burgers & Fries, Costco, Outback Steakhouse, Hops n' Drops, Target, Red Robin, IHOP, Pizza Hut, Taco Bell, Burger King etc. are all within 1 mile of the school). There will also be a fully stocked concession stand at the fields.
