New Custodian

We have hired a new custodian. Nathaniel Davis begins on Thursday, April 29. (His preferred name is Nate.) Nate works a full time job during the day, and will work his position at All Souls in the evenings. We are so glad to have him on board to help us as we begin the process of welcoming our community back to the grounds.

Interfaith Hospitality Network

All Souls can be proud of its support for housing homeless families in apartments through its recent financial donations to Family Promise's (Interfaith Hospitality Network) fundraiser, Night Without a Bed. In addition to the \$1575.00 contributed from the church budget, individual donors contributed \$3585.00. All told almost \$242,000 was collected from 35 churches, companies, and individual donors, 402 of them! This means that in the coming year Family Promise can house 100-130 families for short stays while they get back to financial stability and permanent housing. IHN is, also, resuming the housing of some families in churches in Marion and Hamilton Counties. Due to the pandemic, the number of churches currently able to host has dropped by about one half.



Volunteer to Water Our Trees!

Back in the fall, All Souls added 30 young trees to the property. These new trees need watering any time we have a dry week during their first 3 growing seasons. Recycling at All Souls

Here are some helpful tips on what items are able to be recycled in our parking lot recycling bins. Empty **ink cartridges**, **cell phones**, and other **small electronic devices** are recyclable. Place them in the boxes under the coat rack. A recycling company pays us for these items. **Refilled cartridges** are available from the same company at a reduced price. All Souls receives 15% of the price of these cartridges. To purchase, go to: planetgreenrecycle.com/allsoulsunitarian. Recycling bins are located at the back of the parking lot. All **paper** products except cardboard should be placed in the green and yellow bin. That company pays All Souls for these. Remember to shred any confidential documents.
