Children's and Youth Small Groups:

Spirit Play, Pre-K through 2nd grade or homeschooled equivalent. Join us from 9:30 to 10:15am every 2nd and 4th Sunday for a Montessori-based program that includes storytelling, art, and spiritual exploration. (Spirit Play is on hiatus from January-May during the K-1 OWL program.)

Soul Matters, 3rd-6th grade or homeschooled equivalent. Join us from 9:30 to 10:15am every 2nd and 4th Sunday for small group ministry grounded in our monthly Soul Matters themes.

Youth Drop-In, 8th-12th grade or homeschooled equivalent. Stop by between 6:00 and 8:00 pm on 2nd and 4th Sundays. Bring homework, a hobby, or game to share and spend time in community with other UU youth.




