- 5:15-6:00pm Enjoy a quick rehearsal before the exchange concert.
- 6:00-7:00pm Enjoy a pizza dinner with hosts and change into performance attire.
- 7:30pm ***Exchange Performance*** with The Harker School Orchestra.
- ~9:10pm Following the performance, thank your hosts and load the coaches.
