Parking at Badger High School is a **privilege**. Each student with parking privileges is **expected** to and **MUST** adhere to the following rules:

1. **Pay all outstanding fees/fines in order to obtain a parking permit.**
2. Display your parking permit.
3. **Park ONLY in the designated lot. (Tennis Court Lot, LGMS Lot.)** Students are **NOT** allowed to park in front of or behind the school. In addition, students are **NOT** allowed to park in the Commons or Auditorium parking lots.
4. **Students will be assessed fines for parking in areas designated for visitors and staff.**
5. Park in an actual parking stall, facing forward.
6. Observe all stop signs and speed limits. (Speed limit on school grounds is 5 mph)
7. Wear your seatbelt and **INSIST** your passengers have theirs on at all times while the vehicle is in motion.
8. Drive with safety in mind – for you, your passengers, pedestrians, and school bus zones.

Students may only drive to and from school – NOT during the school day. Any other reason must have parent(s)/guardian permission called into the school office.

Please note: Any violations of the above rules may result in loss of parking privileges and or other disciplinary action. In addition, students who do not meet established academic, discipline or attendance requirements, may be refused parking privileges by the school administration or liaison officer. If a student loses parking privileges and continues to park his/her car in the school lot, or if a vehicle is unregistered, the vehicle may be ticketed, towed and stored at the student's expense.
