Dear Community Leaders,

We are writing to ask you to help us help the people you serve.

The Calvert Concept Charitable Corporation (C4), also known as the Calvert Concept for Reconciliation and Housing, a non-partisan, 501(c)(3) charity, is preparing to accept applications for its program to help correct social injustices through financial and programmatic assistance towards home or business ownership.

There are three beneficiary groups: descendants of enslaved people or Native Americans unfairly kept from home or business ownership; our Calvert County public servants who can't afford to live here; and elderly people whose care of others has greatly depleted their financial resources. Client applications will be available online and at key locations in Calvert County from March 17<sup>th</sup> to April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, and the applications provide more detail about the program. We would greatly appreciate it if you would spread the word and encourage people who may qualify to apply for these benefits.

Online applications will be available on the C4 website, [www.C4housing.org](http://www.C4housing.org), starting March 17<sup>th</sup> and can be submitted via email or in paper form. Pre-printed paper applications will be available at all Calvert Library locations and through organizations who request them. Any Calvert Library location can also assist with scanning and sending paper applications by email or providing addressed, stamped envelopes to mail them.

The deadline for C4 to receive applications is April 10<sup>th</sup>. If a paper application is mailed and date-stamped by the Post Office no later than April 10<sup>th</sup>, it will be considered received by C4 on that date.

If you would like to be one of the locations to receive printed applications for distribution to applicants, please reply to this email and let us know, including the name and location of your organization, the name of a contact person and a phone number. We'll be in touch to make arrangements.
