BIG IDEA:

God Promised Us Mercy

READ :

Genesis 8:15-22; 9:8-17

Last week, we learned about what happened when Adam and Eve disobeyed God. As time went on, other people disobeyed God and eventually, a huge flood covered all the Earth. But God showed mercy to a man named Noah and his family, because Noah loved God. God told Noah to collect the animals and his family on a huge boat, an ark, to ride out 40 days and nights of rain and a huge flood that covered all the earth. The Bible story today is all about God's Covenant with Noah.

DISCUSS:

Parents, here are questions for you to discuss with your kids:

1. What sign did God give Noah to remind him of His promise?
2. What does the word covenant mean?
3. Our BIG IDEA for this week is that God promises to give us mercy. Discuss with your kids what the word mercy means.
4. Describe a time when someone showed you mercy, or when you offered someone else mercy.

MAKE IT:

- Help your kids make a valentine for someone and write the scripture for John 3:16 on it.

Rainbow Prayers:

Using Skittles, or colored cereal— Help lead your kids in these prayers. After each color prayer they may eat that cereal/skittle.

- **PURPLE**—Ask God to show mercy for something you have said or done that was unkind.
- **RED**—Ask God to help you remember how much He loves you!
- **Orange**—Pray for God to help you show mercy to someone who has been unkind to you.
- **Yellow**—Ask God to show mercy for something you have done to harm something in the world God created.
- **Green**—Pray for God to help you take care of God's creation.
- **Purple**—Thank God for His promise of mercy!
