The Zoom Where it Happens:

The platform we are using for the majority of our services (Rosh Hashanah Day One, Rosh Hashanah Day 2, Kol Nidrei and Ne'ilah) is **Zoom Webinar**. This is a streaming platform very much like the Live Stream we offer on Shabbat. **All members in good standing (meaning you have paid 25% towards your 2020-2021 dues or have made payment arrangements) will receive a unique link for each adult member of your household up to two per household.** See ticket policy below for additional links. Links will be sent out a few days prior to Rosh Hashanah.

Regular Zoom links, aside from the Zoom webinar links, will be published and emailed before the holidays for Erev Rosh Hashanah, The Yom Kippur Forum and Yom Kippur Mincha Services.

Our Ticket policy for these holidays are as follows:

1. Any existing member who is current on dues can get additional "tickets" for their adult children at no additional charge. We are giving our members a "special deal" as a reward for membership.
2. If an existing member in good standing wants us to send a link to a relative who lives out of town, we will do this for free but ask for a voluntary donation to TJC.

3. Non-members who belong to another congregation can get a "ticket" to ours for a donation of \$100. No need to prove membership; we will just take your word.
4. Non-members who are not members of another synagogue can buy a package for \$360/person for all services. No individual holiday tickets will be sold. As in previous years, if the person decides to become a member of TJC within the same fiscal year, this will be credited towards their dues.

Adult children and out of town relatives (1 and 2 above) and non-members (3 and 4 above) will not receive The Jewish Center package (makzor, shofar, etc.) but can view the Machzor on our web site.
