Customary for Outdoor Worship Services during COVID September 2020

Typical Participants: 2 clergy, 1 musician, 2 Registration Greeters, 2 Ushers. 2 registered guests may be tapped as readers.

Roles of Registration Greeters and Ushers:

Registration Greeters—Seated at the Registration table, will check people in, take temperatures, and give out numbered bulletins.

Ushers: Will help with traffic flow, making sure that people stay distanced as they wait to check in, help people find their seats, keep people from congregating on the campus before and after the service.

Set up:

- 25 chairs in the courtyard, numbered 1-25. SIP households can be placed more closely together. But otherwise, chairs must be placed with a 6-foot space between them on all sides.
- Barstool for preacher and music stand/lectern for preacher or reader, placed 12 feet away from any participant.
- Registration/Check-in table. Check-in table set up will have:
 - -- Tape marks on the pavement leading to check in with marks spaced 6 feet apart for people waiting to register.
 - --list of participants with contact information for contact tracing.
 - --Infrared thermometer for temperature checks.
 - --Wipes, extra facemasks, hand sanitizer.
 - --Service bulletins, also numbered 1-25.
 - -- Tape marks on the pavement leading to check in with marks spaced 6 feet apart for people waiting to register.

Bathrooms will be open for emergency only. Disinfecting supplies will be provided: Lysol spray, hand soap, hand sanitizer. Signs will be posted on how to disinfect before leaving the bathroom.
