As we have been discussing over the last few months, the charity at our Border Town parishes has been absolutely spectacular! Your kindness towards our **Veterans' Day Collection** resulted in a truckload of gifts that we sent to the facility in Manteno on behalf of those who serve our country and often are forgotten. We very much thank you for your kindness on behalf of our retired service men and women who have sacrificed for our country.

Last week, **Veterans' Floors** gave us an estimate on refinishing the floor at **St. Pat's Academy Gymnasium** to the tune of around \$15,000. Knowing our parish still has to address a \$222,000+ debt, we thought this project would be out of our grasp (as with a church roof, gym bathroom, etc.). One of our anonymous donors was kind enough to pay the cost of the floor renovation IN FULL! – thank you anonymous donor! Because of this generosity, we will undertake this floor renovation from November 14-30 (the first floor of the gym will be closed at this time). The floor should be ready for Van Drunen's three-day Christmas party for their staff the week of December 4.

In the meantime, the good folks at Van Drunen Farms have figured out a way to solve our concrete problem over at our gymnasium floor bathroom project (concrete is really hard to get nowadays!). The bathroom project at St. Pat's has been stalled because of this concrete problem; hopefully we can now move forward so that **Joe Kraus and his sons** can finish their work constructing the bathrooms so that **Joe Cohn and Boss Plumbing** can finish their work as well.

On December 4, Bishop Ronald Hicks comes to both parishes for our Sunday Masses. St. Anne's will celebrate her 150th Anniversary of her church's building at 9:00 a.m. and St. Pat's will host the bishop at the 10:30 a.m. Mass in English and the 12:00 Mass in Spanish. As the bishop attempts to visit all the parishes in the diocese before his consolidation plan takes affect in 2024, it would be nice if we make a nice showing at all our Masses that Sunday.

Dear Padre,

Can all good people go to heaven after they die, even if they haven't been a Christian? My dad is from India and grew up with another religion. The rest of my family is Catholic. I am afraid that we won't see each other again after we die.

Put your mind at ease. A person who is not a Christian can go to heaven. Heaven is not just for Christians, but for everyone who loves God and responds to God's will in his or her life.

We know that God wants all people to be saved, not just Christians. Jesus began a Church to help people achieve salvation. The Church teaches that those who seek "the truth and [do] the will of God in accordance with their understanding of it can be saved" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1260). What we know as Catholics is that God called us into the Church. It is there that we will work out our salvation. "Since Christ died for all, and since all are called to one and the same destiny, which is divine," we must believe that the Holy Spirit makes a way for everyone, a way that only God knows (CCC 1260).

You should pray for your dad and be a faithful Catholic. Perhaps your good example will help him become a Christian. Even if he never becomes a Christian, your prayers will help him work out his salvation without the benefit of the sacraments and a believing community. If he does what is right, God will reward him.

For over 170 years, the faithful of St. Patrick's / Anne's Church have dedicated themselves to serving the folks of our community in God's name. So that we might continue sharing this "Irish Spirit," we ask you to consider the ways listed below that can help our parish, which presents the donor with many options other than cash contributions as they seek to provide help for St. Patrick's / Anne's Church. If you would like to discuss how **ESTATE PLANNING** can be used to make a gift to St. Patrick's / Anne's Church, please call us in the office at ☎ (815) 472-2864.

- ♣ **BEQUESTS** - Through your will you can bequeath to St. Patrick's / Anne's a fixed amount, a percentage of your estate or the remainder after other choices have been made. Example language might be: "To St. Patrick's / Anne's Church of Joliet, I leave the sum of \$75,000 to be used at the discretion of the recipient." Any bequest to St. Patrick's / Anne's you make will reduce the size of your estate and could reduce the estate taxes that may be due.
- ♣ **LIFE INSURANCE** - By naming St. Patrick's / Anne's as the beneficiary of a life insurance



policy your premiums may be tax deductible and it will help ensure the future of St. Patrick's / Anne's Church.

- ♣ **TAX DEFERRED SAVINGS PLANS** - Money in an IRA or other similar plan is subject to income tax when withdrawn and if left in your estate may be subject to estate taxes as well. If you make St. Patrick's / Anne's the remainder beneficiary, neither of those taxes may be paid.
- ♣ A variety of **CHARITABLE TRUSTS AND ANNUITIES** - There are a variety of giving options that can provide you or future generations' income, rights to property or assets with tax savings and generous support to St. Patrick's / Anne's. Please consult with your attorney or other advisor on what is best for you. Always feel free to contact the parish office for more info.

A MESSAGE FROM FR. PETE... with a \$234,000 debt staring at us (down from \$278,000 last year) and major projects that need to be addressed (a new roof on the church, renovation of the parking lots, gym renovations, etc.), we need to provide security for the future of our parish community. Our baptism and marriage numbers are increasing; our Sunday Mass attendance is growing. Here in the border town parishes, so many good souls are coming to Church and seek a bit of hope and light in a society that focuses way too much on darkness.

In past experiences, I have encountered those good people in our communities who wished to help with their time, talent and financial resources but were hamstrung by shady practices that did not allow their resources to be directed to where they wished to go.
