Biography

Dr. Peter Gulick is a Professor of Medicine at Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine and Co-Director of the MSU Internal Medicine Residency Program. Board certified in Internal Medicine, Infectious Diseases, Medical Oncology, and HIV Medicine, he trained at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation and Roswell Park Memorial Institute.

He directs HIV/Hepatitis services at Ingham County Health Department, Great Lakes Bay Medical Center, and Central Michigan Department of Community Health, while also leading infectious disease and hematology education at MSUCOM.

Dr. Gulick founded the MSU-HIV Registry, housing data on over 500 patients and supporting translational research funded by NIH grants. He also serves as an advisor to Gilead, Merck, and ViiV.
