The festival will be along the downtown Courthouse Square, Grenwelge Park and the Historic Red Top Jail area along the banks of the Llano River, just a block away from downtown.

The **Llano Wild West Weekend** festival includes the **Llano River Chuck Wagon Cook-off**, reenactments, kids' activities, and Wild West fun for all ages, including the **PRCA Wild West Rodeo** at the JLK Event Center and Arena. Activities begin Friday, 5:00pm, October 14, and wrap up mid-afternoon Sunday, October 16. **Vendors this year will be located along Haynie and Oatman Streets as well as the courthouse square. Vendor booths open at 10 a.m. on both Saturday and Sunday, with setup beginning 5:00pm, Friday, October 14.**

Vendor Requirements:

1. Vendor spaces (particularly those with electricity) are limited; applications will be taken on a firstcome, first-served basis. **Receipt of completed form and fees by the listed deadlines confirms your interest in participating in the 2016 Wild West Weekend festival.**
2. Applications will be juried to ensure that merchandise is compatible with the goals of the festival; fees will be returned if merchandise is deemed incompatible. Mass-produced carnival-type merchandise will not be accepted.
3. Once accepted, booth fees are not refundable, rain or shine.
4. Vendor booths are assigned by festival organizers. You will be notified of your booth location.
5. Vendor booths are 12'x12'. Please be a good neighbor by keeping your merchandise and equipment within the assigned area.
6. Vendor spaces are outdoors and on hard surfaces; please plan accordingly for shade and securing of canopies.
7. Vendors are responsible for tables, chairs, canopies, electrical cords, or other equipment needed for the booth.
8. Generators are not allowed.
9. Electrical cords must be secured in a manner that will not create a safety hazard.
10. Vendors may set up beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 14.
11. Vendor parking is available behind the City Hall at 301 W. Main; vendor vehicles must be removed from Grenwelge Park area and surrounding streets by 3 pm on Sunday.
12. Food vendors must comply with Texas Department of State Health Services guidelines for Temporary Food Establishments. The City of Llano, the Llano Chamber of Commerce, and Llano County will not be liable for loss or damage of property for any cause, nor will they be responsible for accidents on the grounds, adjacent roads, or highways. Vendors/participants agree to hold harmless the City of Llano, the Llano Chamber of Commerce, and Llano County for any items referenced in item 12.
