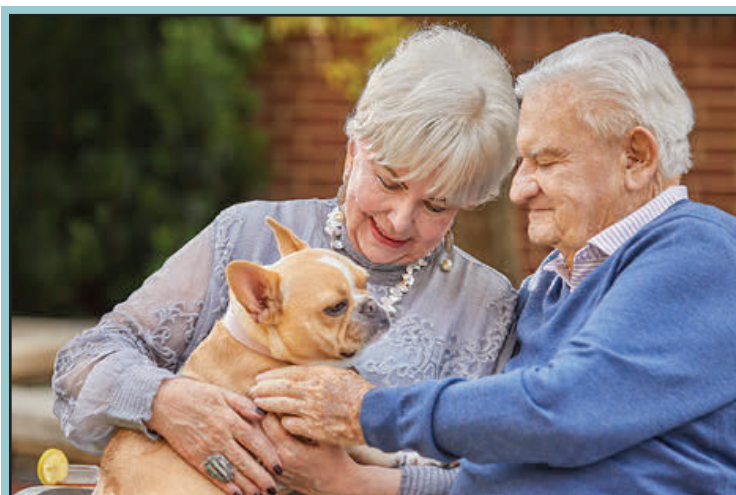

- Feeling Fit Club (FFC):



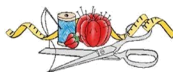

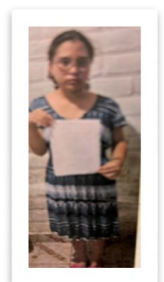
Faithful Advocates and Supporters Are Lights of Hope

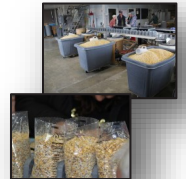

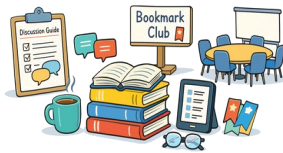

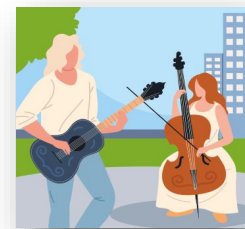

Building Hope Through Christ: How Legacy Gifts Strengthen Care at El Refugio

Hope Without Boundaries supports El Refugio, a home for 160 homeless, aged, infirmed or mentally ill individuals in Tijuana, Mexico.

A grant from Kingdom Builder Foundation in Spring 2025 was used to help to get all the permits and courses needed to make improvements in operations at El Refugio, to be compliant with a recently imposed code. This ensured that the residents of El Refugio could continue to live there, and the ministry could continue to thrive.

Yolanda is an elderly woman living at El Refugio who requires specialized support due to chronic health challenges. Without consistent prescribed medication, she previously experienced episodes that placed her at risk of harm. Following staff training, which implemented a structured medication tracking system, her care has improved significantly. Her quality of life is better and she now can walk in the courtyard of El Refugio without worrying about hurting herself or any other residents. Her life improved by coming to El Refugio, and with the improvements in the infrastructure and training to personnel, it has improved even more.

The biggest improvement is that Jesus came into her life, giving her a family and the hope of eternal life. Now that she has better treatment, she can enjoy church service and worship as well as fellowship with all the people that live at El Refugio.
