THE MOUNT CHESAPEAKE 2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

In order to be considered for the scholarship, each applicant must:

Be a partner of The Mount Peninsula church for at least one year prior to the application deadline and involved in at least one ministry.

Provide the name of ministry/community organization and time period within the last two years that you have been involved. (Must be at least one year within the last two years)

Be a graduating senior with a minimum grade point average of 3.0.

Write an essay that explains how this scholarship can enhance your scholastic and educational goals. (Essay should be no more than one typed page, double spaced in 12 point font and attached to the packet)

Provide an official high school transcript submitted by the school counselor.

Provide two letters of recommendation from non-family members.

One letter must be from a high school teacher, guidance counselor or school administrator and submitted on the school's official letterhead.

The second letter must be a letter of volunteer service from the church, civic, community service organization or extra-curricular activity in your location within the last two years. Your volunteer service must have been for at least one year and the letter must be submitted on official letterhead. (Extra-curricular activities include sports, school clubs and employment)

Provide a copy of an acceptance letter from the institution you may attend on official letterhead or university email.

Include all required signatures.
