

On September 5<sup>th</sup>, Mayor Byron W. Brown announced that the Oxford Square Block Club was the top winner of the City of Buffalo's *Let's DO This!* Block Club Recycling Competition for 2019. The Oxford Square Block Club increased community participation in curbside recycling by 69.84%! Second place went to the Lafayette Ave Block Club. As winners of the competition, these Block Clubs will receive a Community Shredding Event and/or a Street Planter.

The City of Buffalo has expanded their food waste recycling program and renamed the program to *Scrap It!* After getting positive feedback from residents and organizations during the pilot phase of this project last year, the program was expanded to four months, June - September, at five locations citywide: South Buffalo Farmers Market, the Downtown Country Farmers Market Massachusetts Avenue Project Farmstand, North Buffalo Farmers Market, and the Broadway Market. Since June 2019, 1,030 people have participated in the expanded City of Buffalo *Scrap It!* Program and over 4,200 pounds of food scraps have been collected.

**ACCEPTABLE:** Vegetable and Fruit scraps, Coffee Grounds, Tea Bags, Nuts & Eggs shells

**NOT ACCEPTABLE:** meat, chicken, fish, greasy and oily food, dairy, animal waste, litter or bedding, coal, charcoal, coconuts, diseased or insect-infested houseplants, or biodegradable / compostable plastics
