Swimmers will obey all of USA Swimming's rules and codes of conduct.

Coaches will have the final word on any rules, regulations, or disciplinary actions. All swimmers and parents are apprised in writing of these policies.

Signing this document constitutes unconditional agreement to comply with the Honor Code of the York YMCA Swimming Team.

Failure to comply with the Honor Code may result in disciplinary action which may include temporary suspension from training and competition, or dismissal from the team for egregious offenses.
