Program Overview

The Promoting Ethnic Diversity in Zoos (PEDZ) Program is a creative and meaningful summer employment opportunity for highly motivated youth between 14-18 years of age who want to gain work experience and would like to learn more about education, animal care, and zoo operations. The Zoo is looking for responsible, enthusiastic students who can interact positively with guests. Students of all academic levels will be considered for the program. This information packet contains an overview of the program, program requirements, and application.

Since 2002, our nationally-recognized PEDZ Program has provided employment and professional development opportunities for Chattanooga youth. This unique and engaging program allows students to become part-time Zoo employees. Participants engage in a variety of experiences that provide them with opportunities to serve their community, develop career skills, and broaden their understanding of the Zoo's mission. Chattanooga Zoo PEDZ participants work 20 hours per week through June and July. PEDZ positions are available in a variety of departments throughout the Zoo - Education, Guest Services, Maintenance, and Animal Care. As a PEDZ's participant you will have the opportunity to participate in a Professional Development series to help prepare you for entry into the workforce. As we embark on our 20th year we are extremely excited about what the summer 2022 has in store for you, the zoo and our community.

Before you get started, please read through the materials thoroughly. It is important that you decide whether or not this program is right for you. Once you are accepted, we will rely on your commitment for the full duration of the summer program. Most importantly we want you to enjoy this time at the Zoo and be able to make the most of the program!

Requirements

Successful applicants must:

- 🐾 Be age 14-18 years old
- 🐾 Submit a completed application, including:
 - 🐾 Application filled out in its entirety by the student
 - 🐾 1 mandatory and 1 optional reference forms
- 🐾 Complete a mandatory interview
- 🐾 Be willing to work outdoors in all types of weather
- 🐾 Be hardworking and serious about learning
- 🐾 Ability to follow directions

If accepted, you must:

- 🐾 Adhere to program rules and policies
- 🐾 Make a commitment to work 20 hours per week throughout the months of June-July.
- 🐾 Attend a mandatory orientation on the first day of the program

Position Descriptions

Education Department

Education Assistant

Assist the education department by helping prepare for education programs and completing craft projects. Will also assist guests in interpreting and learning about Chattanooga Zoo's exhibits and programs, act as a goodwill guide by helping to answer questions/comments from visitors, and attend various interpretation trainings.

Counselor in Training

As an important part of Zoo Camp Staff, the Counselor in Training (C.I.T.) works in partnership and under the guidance of a Senior Camp Staff, managing and leading a group of kids, ages 5-14. C.I.T's will assist with instruction of fun and educational activities, games, all camp programs and group safety. Activities are focused on animal and environmental curricula as well as team and friendship building skills. C.I.T's will receive training on teaching strategies, curricula, Zoo exhibits and the rules and regulations of the Zoo and Zoo Camp.

Guest Services

Gift Shop Associate

Assist guest services staff with the day-to-day operations of Chattanooga Zoo, which may include but are not limited to: gift sales, customer service, count, mark, and secure incoming merchandise, will greet and assist guests with purchases of Zoo memberships and promote benefits of membership to Chattanooga Zoo, its programs and mission. Other duties might include general housekeeping sweeping, mopping, and cleaning restrooms. While performing *Gift Shop Associates*, should be aware of customer needs, and offer assistance proactively. No two days are the same!

Marketing & Events Department

Administration Assistant

Assist the administration office and marketing/events team in daily tasks and help by prepping and setting up for zoo events. You will learn administration skills and about the business aspects that help maintain a zoo.

Animal Care Division

Keeper Aide

As a Keeper Aide you will be exposed to the natural history and husbandry of the animals under your care. You will assist the Petting Zoo in cleaning of the barn/yard and care of the animals, help Zookeepers with food preparation, and help our rehabilitation center with intake of injured/ill wildlife.

Landscaping Department

Facilities Crewmember

Assist the Maintenance/Landscaping department with the preparation, installation and maintenance of the Zoo's grounds. Crewmember's assist the grounds crew with upkeep of facilities, working on exhibits, and animal holding areas, assist with planting, pruning, watering, weeding, cleaning and performing other related maintenance activities as well as other projects.
