

Election for Board of Directors.

Normally, elections are scheduled in May, with candidates presented in April for members to review. With the delay of the election, the new Board of Directors members will be elected at the July business meeting. We will also be using Absentee ballots

Absentee ballots must be received 1 week before the election date. Absentee ballots may be obtained from the desk or printed from the CSC website: Members will submit absentee ballots in a double envelope; with the ballot in an unmarked envelope placed into an envelope with the member's name clearly printed on the outside envelope. Absentee ballots can be mailed to the Center, attn: Ballot, or given to the executive director or receptionist at the lobby desk. Your envelope containing the ballot will be put into the ballot box in the lobby to be opened at the election.




