- Dishwasher is having issues
 - Pressure release valve being triggered
 - Solution is to replace the pre-heat unit (\$6-7k)
 - Dishwashing chemicals are being used at twice the normal rate
 - Solution is to check with chemical company for recommendations
 - Research being done to replace the dishwasher
 - Dishwasher is original to building (we think)
 - Estimate about \$13.5-\$17k
- Tree work has been done on the property
 - General pruning
 - Remove 2 diseased Crab Apple trees and stumps
 - Replace the cables in the Oak tree in the Peace Garden
 - Costs covered by an anonymous donation
- Working with the Safety Team on security items
 - Camera and viewing software at Narthex entrance
 - Handicapped access for Narthex entrance
 - Red button in Narthex entrance to lock all doors
 - Fobs for locking/unlocking entrance doors
 - Researching classroom lockdown options
- Completed work with the Art Committee
- Engaged Plunkett's for rodent and squirrel issues
 - \$550 for rodents
 - \$500 for squirrels
