In December, Ally Blumenfeld and Nancy Berkenfeld completed a four-week course offered by the National Library of Medicine (<a href="www.nlm.nih.gov">www.nlm.nih.gov</a>) to become Certified Consumer Health Specialists. Just two weeks later, EPL was awarded a \$5,000 Health Information Awareness Award from the U.S. National Library of Medicine! We will be using this award to help sponsor free events and programs throughout the coming year for you and your family.

To effectively meet our goals, we are partnering with Shaping Elizabeth, a City-wide team of community leaders committed to healthy, sustainable living. Shaping Elizabeth asks the provocative question "Why should your zip code be a predictor of your health?" Visit the Library in 2018 to find answers, begin-

ning with our kick-off event, "A Better You 2018."

Join us at the Main Library on January 20th or at Elmora Branch on January 28th to learn about the free programs and resources available to you and your family from Gateway Family YMCA, Trinitas Regional Medical Center, Jewish Family Services, Lifelong Elizabeth, and the City of Elizabeth. There will be activities, prizes, refreshments, and a chance to share with us your healthrelated resolutions for 2018.

We want to help make this year your best yet!






