

Do you know the difference between Urgent Care, the ER, and Freestanding ERs?

Don't pay more than you need to!

<p>Usually a 1-story building!</p> <p>Urgent Care is for health problems that need treated right away but are NOT a danger to your life or a risk of losing a limb. For example, Urgent Care can treat a sore throat, fever, flu, vomiting, sprains, or headaches.</p> <p>You should use Urgent Care when your doctor is not available, outside of normal office hours (nights & weekends), or when you need medical attention right away.</p>	<p>At least a 6-story building!</p> <p>A hospital Emergency Room (ER) is for life-threatening health emergencies, such as a heart attack, stroke, or major cut that needs surgery.</p> <p>These Emergency Rooms (often called ERs) are part of a hospital. They are usually located inside the hospital and you can be admitted to the hospital that it is connected to, if needed.</p>	<p>Usually a 2-story building!</p> <p>A freestanding Emergency Room (ER) is an Emergency Room that is not attached to a hospital. The problem is that it looks like an Urgent Care and you may go there by mistake.</p> <p>People often get confused and go there when they don't have an emergency. But a visit to one of these locations is the same as going to a hospital ER. However, it can lead to higher costs and an extra visit to a hospital ER.</p>
