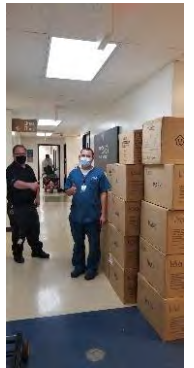


April 1, 2021 – LACMA partners with Wesley Health Center
