

Community Connections Outreach Program

Matching one local family with one NCWC international student staying in the residence halls during the summer of 2020

REQUIREMENT: HOST your student for a meal (in your home or out at a restaurant, picnic, etc) once a month during the summer. May (if the restrictions lessen and they can leave campus), June, July, and August.

(If you aren't able to make this commitment, we have plenty of other opportunities for you to be involved with our students. Just let Suzanne Hening know.)

OPTIONAL:

- Contact your student several times a month to check on them.
- You can get together with them as much or as little as you like. Just make sure you have (at least) one meal together a month.
- You can offer to take them on day trips-- the beach Raleigh, hiking trails, Mudcats, anywhere in our great area (after the places reopen.)
- You can offer to provide transportation to take them on errands-- Walmart, Target, Food Lion, etc.
- You can ask them if they'd like to bring a friend(s) for outings. That is entirely up to you.

Note: We ask that you do not consume or offer alcohol while with our students.

TO BEGIN: 1. Fill out the Community Family application (if you haven't already been involved in any of our International student activities). 2. Get in touch with your student as soon as you get their name and contact info. You can mail and/or email them.
