

Project AGAPE

Project AGAPE's ministry has included building schools and medical clinics, launching orphanages, helping construct churches and renovating houses. It has sponsored agricultural development through the provision of livestock, chickens, agricultural tools and seeds.

Last September, Azerbaijan launched a full-scale attack against the region where Project AGAPE is in ministry. Many people, including women, children and the elderly, have migrated to Armenia to seek safety in temporary shelters. The Project AGAPE one-room office in Yerevan now hosts four children refugees from Berdzor.

The four buildings of the Project AGAPE Center in Berdzor were significantly damaged by a cluster bomb. The staff has removed everything from the buildings and evacuated. They are now operating out of a large warehouse in Goris.
