Student Outcomes

1,339 students in grades 1-5 received tutoring for 30 minutes twice per week:

- ▶ 96% of students met growth goals set with guidance from elementary math specialists
- ▶ 92% of teachers saw an increase in confidence and/or enthusiasm for math as a result of the program

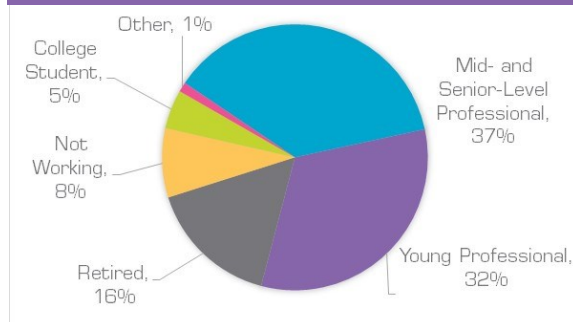

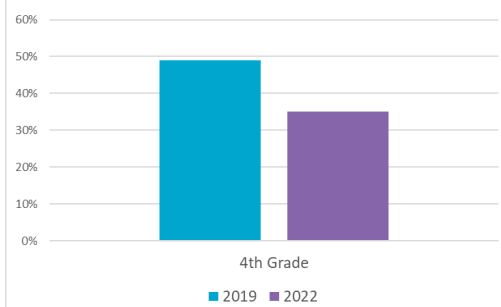
Need for Math Tutoring in CMS

► Elementary math proficiency matters for a student's self-identity as a successful student, middle school preparedness, high school graduation, and postsecondary and career options.

► Our community and students are missing out when only 35% of Charlotte 4th graders are proficient in math, as evidenced by 2022 NAEP scores. This represents a decline from pre-pandemic proficiency levels.

► Heart's program focuses on elementary-aged students who may not otherwise have access to resources for private tutoring and are performing 2-3 years below their grade level in math.
